
Easter People

Dear Friends,

Happy Easter! May the promised glory of the Lord's Resurrection fill your minds and hearts -- and those of your families and friends -- with great love and joy this Eastertide.

I must be honest with you, I really did not want Lent to end. Many of you have heard me say, especially in homilies at the Daily Mass, that, "I live for Lent!" Lent 2023 has been one of the most challenging, hopeful, and yet satisfying liturgical seasons I've celebrated in years. Perhaps the secret to that success is that I put considerable time and energy into living these 40+ Days differently, with a sobering mindfulness and resolute spirit to live life freed from clutter, noise and distractions! 
And yet, dear parishioners, while the "Catholic Culture" that has engaged me during Lent has been such a blessing to me, personally and spiritually, I will not hesitate to abandon such

practices come Easter - only in order to celebrate this new time of year in a very different way. We are a *seasonal* Church, and the Fulfillment of the penitential season of Lent gently gives way to the Easter celebration of the, "source and summit" of our Salvation in Christ. 
Summer Cleaning Positions Available




