Toiletries for the Altrusa House and St. John's Homeless Shelter

The Altrusa House, located near the hospitals, removes the additional burden lodging can add to a medical crisis. Over the past 20 years it has been a significant source of hope, providing more than 70,000 nights of compassionate service to families from 42 states and 7 countries. It has been 'A Home Away from Home' for those who travel to Green Bay for medical care, at no cost to the guest staying there. Altrusa House provides toiletries for their guests who are unprepared for a stay overnight, or many nights, to be near their loved one. The home gives them shampoo, conditioner, bars of soap, lotion, mouthwash, toothbrushes and paste in travel sized containers.

As you know, we also provide donations to St. John's Homeless Shelter. They can also use these items. We will divide what is collected between the two facilities.

Therefore, if you have any of these toiletry items collected at home from your travels, you can donate them to a good cause. **Please Note:** The DePere Health Dept. asks that your donations be unopened, in original packaging from your recent travels over the past few years. You can also donate the travel sized toothpaste and the toothbrushes you receive from visiting the dentist. There will be a container by the St. Michael Chapel from **April 21-May 12** to put your donations in. Thank you for thinking of others.

“Peter v2.0”

In this weekend’s first 2 readings, we hear about the boldness of Peter. Both in the Act of the Apostles and Peter’s first letter to new Christian communities, he is clearly speaking with authority. Peter has boldly become the leader of the Apostles and is fearlessly proclaiming Jesus to the people. But Wait! Who is this guy?? This is not the same Peter we’ve been hearing about to this point. “This Peter” we hear from today is not like the old Peter. This guy is different. Where was “this Peter” when Jesus asked him to stay up and pray with him in the garden of Gethsemane? Where was “this Peter” when he stepped out of the boat and wanted to walk on water and failed? Where was “this Peter” when people accused him of being a follower of Jesus and he denied knowing Jesus not once...but 3 times? The short answer. “This Peter” hadn’t encountered the Holy Spirit yet. The Peter we hear about this morning has moved from being a mere follower of Jesus to a full-blown disciple of the Lord.



And what a transition it was! Peter went on to proclaim the Gospel to Jews and Gentiles. He boldly spread the word of Jesus even to the point of being crucified (upside down) on the cross. The man who once denied Jesus for fear of being crucified, gladly accepted his cross after allowing the Holy Spirit to transform his life.

We also must boldly seek out and accept the Holy Spirit. As we near Pentecost, take steps to allow the Holy Spirit to enter our lives and change it forever. Pray to the Holy Spirit to move us from mere followers of Jesus to emboldened disciples of the Lord. Spend this Easter Season reading the Acts of the Apostles, accept the call to make disciples of Jesus wherever you go.

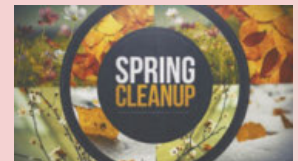

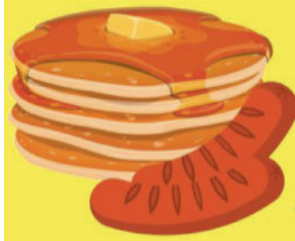

Walk to Mary

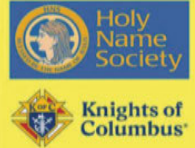
