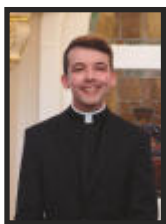

FROM FATHER CARLOS



Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

The Catechism of the Catholic Church, in speaking about Divine Providence, reminds us that even though Creation “has its own goodness and proper perfection... it did not spring forth complete from the hands of the creator” (302.)

The universe, instead, was created “in a state of journeying’ toward an ultimate perfection yet to

be attained, to which God has destined it.” The Catechism, thus, defines Divine Providence as “[these] dispositions by which God guides his creation toward this perfection.”

God, indeed, directs all things towards its perfection, including realities that apparently are good as they are and might not seem to be in need of further “finishing.” One example is our moments of joy and laughter. They too fall under God’s providential care and God directs them towards greater perfection.

In order to cooperate with God’s grace and to allow those moments of joy and laughter to be guided by divine providence, it is important that we take a deeper look at the motives behind our joy. In order to do this, I invite us to ask the following set of questions: what causes me to rejoice? What kind of things makes me happy? Do I rejoice over the right thing?

Now, there is a logical question that follows here: and, what is the right thing to rejoice over? In the Gospel of Luke, the Lord gives us an answer to this question. After having sent seventy-two disciples on mission (10:1) they now return, the Gospel says, “rejoicing, and [say] to the Lord: ‘Lord, even the demons are subject to us because of your name’” (10:17.) The Lord Jesus,

who is God, wants to bring their joy to a greater perfection and says to them: “do not rejoice because the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice because your names are written in heaven” (v. 20.)

Ultimately, it is as if the Lord was telling them: “Rejoice over the things from above, the things of heaven.” Now, we might ask, and what is in heaven, or rather, who is in heaven that should be the cause of our joy? The answer is, of course, God, our Father who loves us so dearly that He even wants to bring our joy to a greater perfection so that “[His] joy may be in [us] and [our] joy may be complete.” That we are loved that much by the Father is the right cause for our rejoicing.

Our Blessed Mother is a most perfect example of rejoicing over the right things, the things from above. When she goes out to visit her cousin Elizabeth, she is filled with joy by the Holy Spirit and says, “My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord, my Spirit rejoices in God my savior” (Luke 1:46-47.) Her joy was God who is savior and who had looked upon her with favor, doing great things for her (see vv. 48-49.)

Brothers and sisters, as the time for the presidential election approaches where some will “rejoice” over the results and others will not, it is important that we allow our joy to be perfected by God’s providential plan. That we are infinitely loved by the Father should be our ultimate cause for rejoicing. May these days be an opportunity to rejoice over this, to let ourselves be overcome by the joy of knowing ourselves are dearly beloved by God. The Almighty does great things for us as well, “let us rejoice and be glad in [him]” (Psalm 118:24.)
