AMEN.*

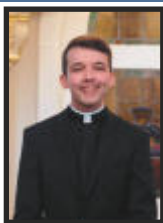

## FROM FATHER CARLOS



Dear friends at Saint Frances Cabrini and Saint Mary's parishes,

Last Friday we celebrated the solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

It is a gift to have a specific day and traditionally a month, the month of June, to celebrate the Heart of God. The Lord's heart is one that loves every man and woman of this earth with a love that is beyond all telling.

As we look at the images of the Sacred Heart, we learn that it is wounded and pierced. Traditional depictions of the Heart of the Lord have his heart surrounded by a crown of thorns. Why would the divine healer not heal the wounds of his own heart? Why does his heart remain pierced, crowned with thorns? Such is the wisdom of the Heart of God, a Heart that embodies his own words: "In the world you will have trouble, but take courage, I have conquered the world" (John 16:33.) The reality of suffering, pain and ultimately evil are, to an extent, part of the picture: that is the reason why it is fitting that the Heart of Jesus is crowned with thorns. The Sacred Heart, however, has "conquered the world." No evil inflicted upon the Heart of God at the time of his passion stopped it from loving those he redeemed by his own precious blood. The waters of death could not quench the flames that come out of God's most loving Heart for "deep waters cannot quench love, nor rivers sweep it away" (Song of Songs 8:7.)

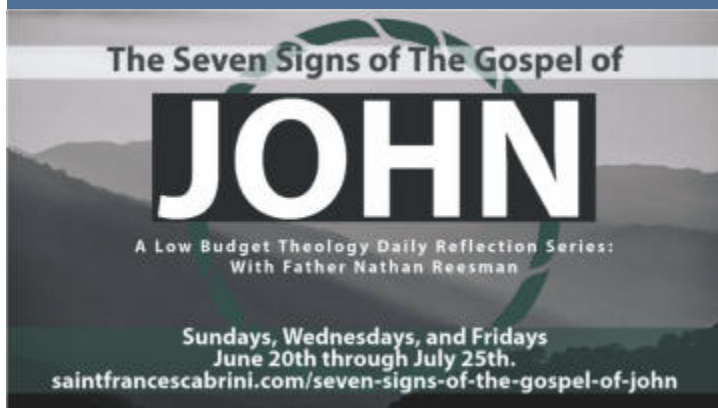
The reality of evil in the world should not make us fear or become anxious: "I have told you this so that you might have peace in me" (John 16:33,) says the Lord. Peace is one of the major gifts given by the Sacred Heart. One day, after the Lord's resurrection, he appeared to his disciples and said to them: "Peace be with you" (John 20:26.) Linked to the gift of peace that the Lord gave the apostles was his invitation to one of them, Thomas, to put his hand into his side and to feel his beating Heart (see John 20: 26-27.) The certainty that his love never fails, that his love is everlasting (see Psalm 136) and that his Heart has triumphed over sin and all its manifestations should truly fill our own hearts, as it filled Thomas', with the peace that every heart longs for. Only the Lord's love wins.

"Jesus, meek and humble of heart, make my heart like unto Thine."

In asking the Lord to make our hearts like unto his, we are also asking the Lord that we may never quit loving even when life crowns our hearts with thorns. Mother Theresa beautifully explained what it means to love in the image and likeness of the Heart of the Lord when she said, "I have found the paradox, that if you love until it hurts, there can be no more hurt, only more love."

As we continue praying for an increase in Mass attendance at our parishes, we look upon the heart of Jesus and we ask that the flames of his heart may warm the hearts of those who have grown cold in the practice of the faith. We also continue asking for the grace that our hearts may be more like the Lord's own heart so that we may always love God and neighbor, even when it hurts.

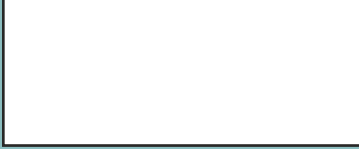
