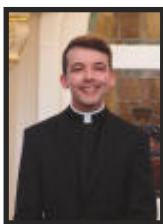

Dear friends at Saint Mary's and Saint Frances Cabrini parishes.

It has only been a little over a year since I was ordained a priest and I have found the sacrament of anointing of the sick to be one of the most beautiful and impactful moments of my priesthood.

In the Gospel proclaimed this weekend at Mass, the author narrates how the Lord "summoned the twelve and began to send them out two by two" (Mark 6:7.) Later, the Gospel says that "the twelve drove out many demons, and they anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them" (6:13.)

The sacrament of the sick is a tangible manifestation of God's mercy. As the priest anoints the person on the forehead and the palm of the hands, he asks the Lord who "forgives sins" that he may "save" and "raise up" the person that is being anointed.

When we are sick or even dying, we are also at our most vulnerable and yet it is then that the Lord comes with his help to forgive, to save and to raise us up. Such has been God's pedagogy throughout history: coming to the assistance of the poor ones, those who are most vulnerable and in need of his help.

Anointings are also a manifestation of the multifaceted power of God's healing. There are times in which families have come together to pray for a loved one who is sick. These have been occasions for healing of relationships as well, as they all gather as one around their loved one asking the Lord the same prayer: that their loved one may be healed or comforted in their time of sickness.

Anointings have also been a time to witness the power of the sacrament of marriage. When both spouses are present and I am called to anoint one of the two, I have witnessed the power of their love for one another in the way they care for the spouse who is sick. The scene teaches all the present in the room about the fact that God assists with his grace those who enter into the sacrament of marriage, and his help is faithful to the end. These occasions have also been an opportunity to witness the fact that a love that is faithful (for as long as both shall live) and fruitful is not just an ideal but a concrete reality in the lives of many with the help of God.

The sacrament of the sick sometimes includes what is usually known as "the last rites." They are a set of prayers that the priest offers, entrusting to the Lord a brother or a sister in Christ that is transitioning from this life into eternity. They are another channel of God's infinite mercy which comes to assist the dying so that they may not lose hope in the fact that our merciful Father will not let anyone of his faithful children perish but that he will raise them up on the last day.

May these lines bring us to give thanks for the sacrament of anointing of the sick and for all the sacraments of the Church. They truly make present Christ in our midst and are the ordinary means by which God comes to our assistance to forgive, to save and to raise us up.

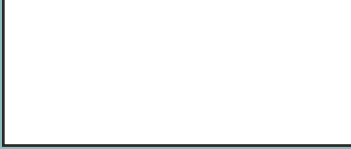
