

Caring for God's Creation

"Care for Creation" and Laudato Si' (Part 4)

The Pope's encyclical, *Laudato Si'*, challenges us to rethink our relationship with nature.

The text confirms that a truly ecological approach is also inherently social - an approach that simultaneously hears "the cry of the earth and the cry of the poor."

We need to be aware that consumerist economic ideologies often leads to a wrongheaded idea of dominion over nature. The result is exploitation, and a throwaway attitude towards nature and human life itself. "Caring for ecosystems demands farsightedness." People looking for quick profits are rarely interested in preserving ecosystems.

The document is hopeful, reminding us that because God is with us, we can strive both individually and corporately to change course. We can awaken our hearts and move towards an "ecological conversion" in which we see the intimate connection between God and all beings.

Finally, we as individual believers, families and communities, are invited to make a difference in small but tangible ways with responsible and sustainable consumption. We can have an impact on our Care for Creation by what we do and how we consume.
