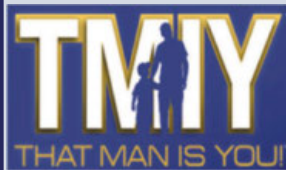

RCIA: The Scrutinies

What are the Scrutinies of the Elect*

Starting next week at the 11am Mass, the community celebrates the Scrutinies during Lent for all the unbaptized Elect who will be baptized at the Easter Vigil. The word "scrutiny" refers to the self-searching of the Elect. These Rites are designed to heal all that is weak and sinful in the hearts of the candidates and to strengthen all that is upright and good. They include prayers of exorcism and call for deep repentance. The First Scrutiny fills their spirit with Christ the Redeemer, who is the living water (Gospel of the Samaritan woman); the Second Scrutiny is the One who is the light of the world (Gospel of the man born blind); the Third Scrutiny is the One who is the Resurrection and the Life (Gospel of Lazarus).

*An un-baptized person who has gone through the Rite of Election, signifying their being chosen for the Sacraments of Initiation.

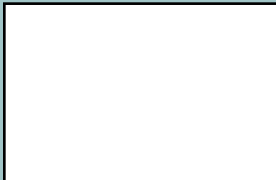
