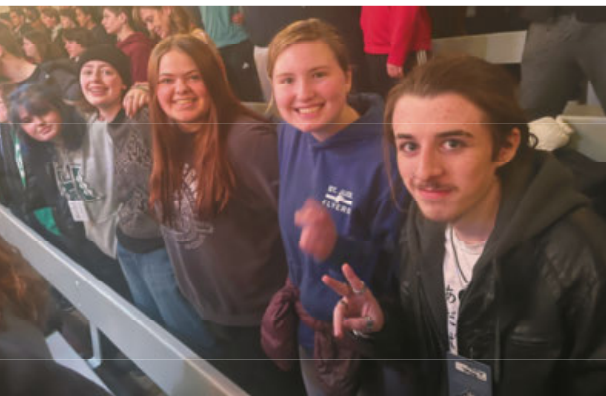
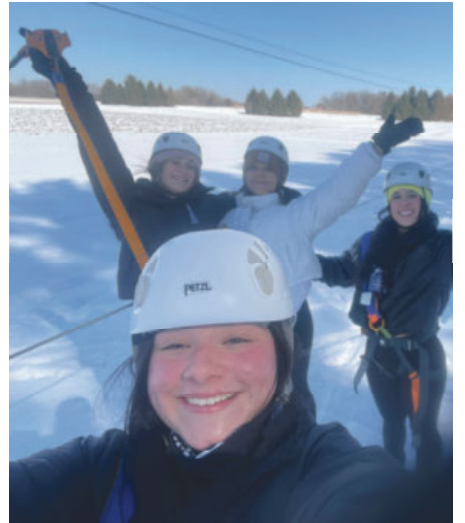


2022 Winter Xtreme
