



As we prepare for the garden's second year, the Peace and Justice Committee is asking if there are any gardeners, experienced or not, who would like to join the fun as we refresh the beds, try some new vegetables, water, then harvest and deliver to those in need. 
According to the teens, their favorite parts were: impacting speakers, zip lines, worship time, forming bonds with new people and strengthening current connections, seeing God in others!
