**First Reading:**

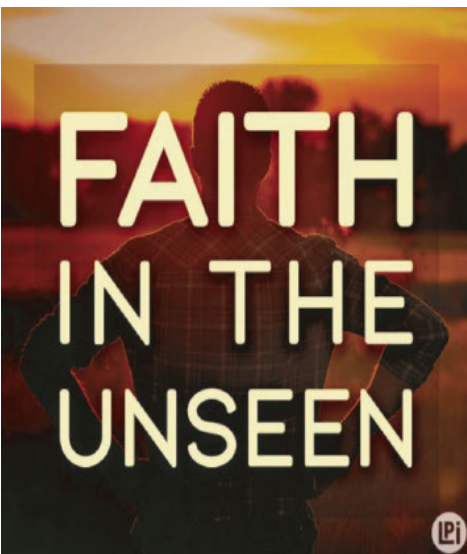
Our wisdom writer speaks of the importance of trust in God's divine providence. How do you know that God has provided for you?

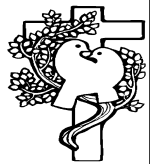
