SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

The Pastoral Guidelines for Marriage Preparation require a minimum of *six months be set aside for personal preparation for marriage*. Couples should refrain from setting a firm date until they have talked to the Pastor to discuss Marriage plans. *At least one of the persons to be married must be a registered member of the parish and liturgically active before the wedding date.*

FROM THE DESK OF THE PARISH ADMINISTRATOR



Dear Parishioners,

As promised, this is the second installment regarding the Eucharist. In last week's bulletin column (and Mass homily), I explained that **the Eucharist satisfies our spiritual hunger for God**. This week, I will consider **the Eucharist as a sacrifice that gives life to the world**.

In the first reading from the book of Exodus, the people are starving to death in the desert. To save their lives, the Lord rains down bread (manna) from heaven.

As Jesus commences his Bread of Life Discourse in the Gospel, he references the manna in the desert. But he explains that the manna gave only temporary sustenance, not give eternal life. Rather, the bread that comes from the Father gives everlasting life. Of course, this "bread of life" is Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist.

Why does the Eucharist give eternal life? Because the **Eucharist is a sacrifice. And by way of sacrifice, life comes thru death.**

Salvation history centers upon various ways that God saves his people from the effects of their own sin, which all lead both to physical and spiritual death. One way he does this is by instructing the people to offer various sacrifices—typically animals—to atone for their disobedience and infidelity.

But, as the author of the Letter to the Hebrews explains, the sacrifices of the Temple priests could never entirely take away sins. Only the perfect sacrifice of Jesus Christ takes away the sins of the world, saves people from eternal death, and offers them eternal life.

So what does this have to do with the Mass? The Mass is the perpetuation of the sacrifice of Christ, which gives life to the world. While the word "perpetuation" isn't exactly common lingo, it describes well how the Mass continues or perpetuates the one sacrifice of Jesus Christ and its life-giving effects.

In short, the Mass is the sacramental representation of the one sacrifice of Christ. By our prayerful presence at Mass, we participate in this ongoing memorial, which is our path from the death of sin to the life of grace!
