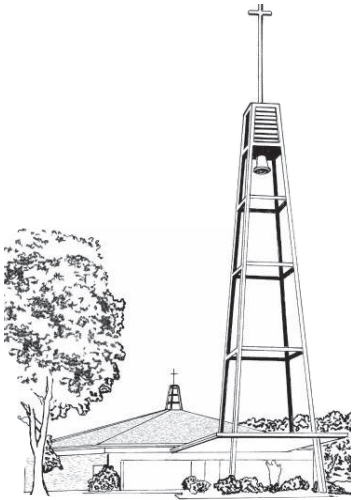

## SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

## SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

The Pastoral Guidelines for Marriage Preparation require a minimum of *six months be set aside for personal preparation for marriage*. Couples should refrain from setting a firm date until they have talked to the Pastor to discuss Marriage plans. *At least one of the persons to be married must be a registered member of the parish and liturgically active before the wedding date.*

# FROM THE DESK OF THE PARISH ADMINISTRATOR



Dear Parishioners,

As we progress further into the Bread of Life Discourse in John 6, Jesus reinforces the theme of last week's Gospel: "I am the Bread of Life...whoever eats this Bread will live forever." Last week, I explained how the celebration of the Eucharist—the Mass—is the sacrifice that permits such everlasting life. This week, I want to focus on another dimension of the Eucharist, namely, communion. The Eucharist is our source of communion with God and with one another.

As human persons, we are made in the image of God, who is a communion of divine Persons. As such, we are called to communion. Here and now, we all sense a desire for communion. We often act on this desire for communion by engaging in various social activities. But what we often find is that, as good as these social groups are, they are always imperfect.

To overcome the deficiencies and flaws of familial and social groups so as to enter into deeper communion with others, we first need to enter into deeper communion with God. And what is the source of the most profound communion with God? The Eucharist.

Let's back up a bit. Last week, I explained that during the Feast of Passover, God required the sacrifice of thousands of lambs. What I didn't mention is that after these lambs were slaughtered, the people had to eat the lamb. That was central to the Feast.

In Christ, all the old sacrifices are fulfilled. Christ is the lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world, once and for all. But it's not enough to merely commemorate his sacrifice on the Cross with every Mass. We also must consume his Body and Blood.

When we approach the altar worthily (i.e. not being conscious of serious sin that would entirely divorce us from God), and consume the Body and Blood of Jesus, we are given the gift of entering into a holy communion with him. Hence, we call it Holy Communion.

Once we are united to God in this most profound communion, we can also be united with one another in a supernatural way through the Church, which is the Body of Christ. The Eucharist makes the Church.

The deepest communion that we as baptized Catholics desire above all else is found nowhere other than the Most Holy Eucharist.

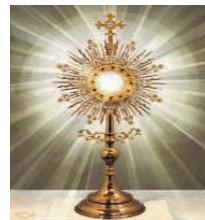
