MAY 23, 2021—PENTECOST SUNDAY

Dear Parishioners,

Happy Pentecost! Having celebrated the joy of the Resurrection for seven weeks, we now arrive at one of the most important Solemnities of the Liturgical Year. Pentecost is the celebration of the gift of the Holy Spirit upon the Church. The Holy Spirit is like the soul of the Church, the Body of Christ. The Holy Spirit animates the life of the Church. For this reason, there is a tradition of considering Pentecost as the beginning of the Church.



The Holy Spirit is not a nebulous thing that floats around the world; the Holy Spirit is specifically the Third Person of the Most Holy Trinity. The Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son. Indeed, the Holy Spirit is the mutual love between the Father and the Son.

The three Persons of the Trinity always act together; however, there are certain actions that we appropriate to distinct Persons. Sanctification is an action commonly appropriated to the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit sanctifies us (makes us holy) through the Sacraments, through prayer, and through living lives of charity.

We receive the Holy Spirit and the Gifts of the Holy Spirit when we are baptized. (The gifts are wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord). These gifts are strengthened when we are confirmed. This strengthening, or sealing, helps us carry out our mission to spread the Gospel throughout the world! This is why Confirmation is an essential Sacrament of Initiation. If you are not Confirmed, please contact me right away so that you can begin preparations to be confirmed next year!

A simple way to make the Holy Spirit a bigger part of your spiritual life is to pray to the Holy Spirit. Perhaps you want to begin daily by praying the following prayer:

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth.

O, God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy His consolations. Through Christ Our Lord, Amen.

Let us pray that the Holy Spirit would fill our hearts and make us zealous for the Kingdom of God!

You have 181 chances to win and your ticket goes back in after you have won!

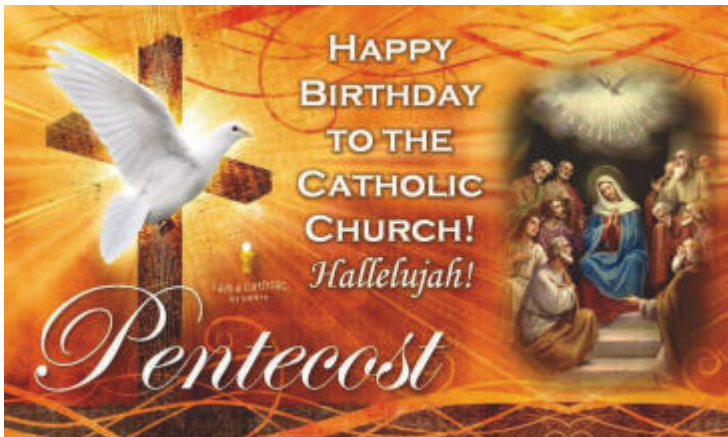
