

JUNE 27, 2021—13TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Parishioners,

Whenever I find myself at the St. Matthew's Cemetery in Campbellsport, I always take some time to walk around the seemingly endless rows of headstones marking the graves of the School Sisters of St. Francis. I am humbled by their lives. While they all contributed something unique to the Church, they all responded to the same call to leave everything and follow Christ, who promised: "Everyone who has given up houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or children or lands for the sake of my name will receive a hundred times more, and will inherit eternal life" (Mt 19:29).



Fifty years ago, there were over 5,000 religious sisters who worked in the ten counties of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. Now, most living religious sisters (and nuns) are retired and only a handful are still engaged in active ministry.

Because we do not see sisters around schools, hospitals, and parishes, we can easily forget about vocations to women's religious life and think that religious sisters are something of the past, seen only in black and white films of the 1950s. But we must resist thinking this way. A Church without women spiritually espoused to Christ is an unhealthy Church. The Body of Christ needs the witness of women (and men) who seek to live the Gospel radically by being consecrated to Christ in poverty, chastity, and obedience.

Fortunately, there is good news: new, vibrant religious orders are growing and attracting young women. Just last year, about a dozen young women from the Archdiocese of Milwaukee all entered religious communities in other parts of the country. Please start praying that some of these growing communities set up shop in southeastern Wisconsin.

I have often heard older priests say that the Church in America was built upon the fidelity of women in religious life. I believe this to be true. A Church without female religious, in which only priests are visible, is a lopsided Church. It does not make sense to see only men and not women embrace the vocation to live celibacy for the Kingdom.

With all this in mind, I will finally get to my primary point: we need to do whatever we can to plant the seeds of vocations to religious life for women. Without sisters in our schools to inspire vocations, this is undoubtedly a formidable challenge. One small attempt to subtly suggest religious life to young girls is through the Holy Trinity & St. Michael altar guild, which has been going for a couple months. This group meets periodically to pray together and receive some extra personal formation about being a Catholic woman. It also has the parish apostolate of decorating the Churches and setting up for Mass in conjunction with the sacristans. I pray that this group continues to grow and to find in new ways to serve so as to become more visible.

The altar guild encourages girls to volunteer in ways that are in continuity with a vocation to religious life. It is complemented by the server's guild, which is ordered toward priesthood. I hope that these two complementary groups will implicitly communicate the lesson that roles in the Church, based upon gender, can be different without one or the other having more or less value or importance.

By giving our young parishioners in the altar guild and server's guild a special task in the Church for which they can take a sense of "ownership," the idea of a vocation is planted even without many words. From my experience, a small nudge usually is better received than a lecture. My hope is that both of these groups would provide age-appropriate discernment simply by sparking teenagers' curiosity about the Church, the Sacraments, and a life entirely given to the service of God. Of course, most of these boys and girls will not sense a vocation to religious life or priesthood, but this additional formation will still be valuable as it will prepare them to live their lives as faithful Catholics.

Please join me in praying for all young Catholics, that they would be faithful to Christ and his Church and also that more women and men from our parishes would be inspired to offer the entirety of their existence, without compromise, to Jesus Christ.



SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM - Preparation for the Sacrament of Baptism involves special instruction for the parents. Please call the parish office preferably before the child is born for more information and to schedule a Baptism. BAPTISM SPONSORS: According to Canon Law, the sponsor must be a practicing Catholic who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation, at least 16 years old, active member of their parish and if married, they must be in a sacramental (valid) marriage. If two sponsors are chosen, there should be one male and one female. BAPTISM CLASS: If this is your first child OR there is a three-year gap from when you first took the class, both parents are required to attend the Baptism class. The Godparents are encouraged to attend if they are able. Baptism Classes are held every third Sunday of the month in the Holy Trinity café from 8:15 a.m. – 10:45 a.m. Continental breakfast is provided. Daycare may be available upon request. Registration deadline is the Tuesday before the class.


SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE – Contact the parish at least six months in advance of the anticipated wedding date. Couples should refrain from setting a firm date until they have talked to the Priest to discuss Marriage plans. At least one of the parties must be a registered, practicing Catholic member of our parish.
