

JANUARY 16, 2022—2ND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Parishioners,

The decorations have been taken down and the green vestments have returned. On the liturgical calendar, we are living Ordinary Time.

There are two times throughout the year when we journey through Ordinary Time: after the Christmas Season and after the Easter Season. During both of these periods, we are invited to incorporate into our "ordinary" lives the "extraordinary" graces of the greatest feasts Christmas and Easter. This means that the graces of Easter (and Pentecost) should animate the Church throughout the summer/fall months of Ordinary Time and the graces of Christmas should animate the January/February months of Ordinary Time.



The gift of Christmas is the gift of God, who has come to us in the Person of Jesus Christ. The Second Person of the Trinity takes on a human nature to save us, to make us sons and daughters of God, and to assure us that we are not alone: God is with us.

A specific way to extend the Christmas grace of God's presence throughout Ordinary Time is by spending time in Eucharistic Adoration. At Christmas, God comes to us in the flesh and in the Eucharist God remains with us in the flesh. As you know, we have adoration at our parishes on Tuesday night (HT), Wednesday night (SM), and Friday throughout the day (HT).

We also will soon have another great opportunity for Eucharistic Adoration. In a couple months, the Mary Queen of Angels Adoration Chapel at St. Francis Cabrini Parish will open. If enough adorers commit to praying for an hour every week, this chapel will be open for adoration 24 hours a day, 7 days a week!

Having a perpetual Eucharistic Adoration Chapel in the area would be a great blessing to all of us. For this reason, both of our finance councils each decided to donate \$1,000 to the construction of this chapel. Consider the great consolation of knowing that anytime, day or night, you could stop by the chapel and know that our Eucharistic Lord would be waiting for you there! For some of you who live or work near this new chapel or daily drive through the area, this adoration chapel will be particularly convenient.

If you do not already adore the Lord for an hour every week at Eucharistic Adoration, I challenge you to try to fit an hour of adoration into your weekly schedule. To help you resolve yourself to make this commitment, you will find sign-up sheets at the entrances of our churches whenever adoration is going on. To sign up for an hour at the Mary Queen of Angels Adoration Chapel, go to wbadoration.org. Also, to help you pray at Eucharistic Adoration, remember that for Christmas we gave each household a book of prayers/reflections (*The Adoration Companion*). If you did not receive a copy, there are extras at each parish.

None of us knows what is in store for us during this new year, but if we commit to adoring the Lord each week, we will know for sure that the Lord will be with us every step of the way.


WOMEN OF HOPE BOOK GROUP AT HOLY TRINITY
