JANUARY 23, 2022—3RD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Friends,

Today's second reading is a famous reading from St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians. We've heard it many times, and we understand the general gist. We are together the Body of Christ, and each of us are parts of His Body, incorporated via our Baptism into the Church. St. Paul's famous analogy of the Church as the Body of Christ can help us come to know certain truths much needed for the Church today.

The first is that we become members of **Christ's body**. This is key because it is in our unity with Christ alone that we find our true happiness and fulfillment in life. The gift and call of being a Christian is coming to understand our lives in light of the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. The gate through which we pass to be able to come to this understanding is the Sacrament of Baptism, whereby we are incorporated into Christ's body.

The second truth is that each of us **belongs as a part** of the whole. This means that each of us has received a unique gift and call from God to build up the Church. In the tradition, we call these particular ways of building up the Church charisms. The eye is not the ear, nor is the hand the foot. Each person has a particular way(s) that God has invited him or her to build up the Church. St. Paul also gives examples of charisms: to be apostles, prophets, teachers, performers of mighty deeds, healers, those who provide assistance, administrators, gifts of tongues, and interpreters. Other charisms are given to the Church through the gifts of the Holy Spirit that are poured out on us in a profound way during the Sacrament of Confirmation. These gifts are wisdom, understanding, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. All gifts given to us by God are meant to be in some way shared with others.

The third truth is not only do others need our gifts, we need others' gifts. We are not self-sufficient beings unto ourselves, who need no assistance, love, or help from others. This is a hard one, especially for young people today. We need other people. Relying on other people is necessary to function as a healthy and happy human person. None of us has all of the gifts, and none of us has none of the gifts. Everyone gives, and everyone receives. We must fight against the temptation to be self-reliant in our lives. While I was away on retreat last week, I came across the helpful line from St. Teresa of Avila: "My self-reliance almost killed me." It is a temptation for all of us to be alone and to want to prove to ourselves and others that we are good enough. But that is not how we were made and not why we were made.

There is a key difference between the two words **imitation** and **participation** regarding our lives with Christ. Imitation implies that we like certain qualities of someone, and we seek to model our lives after those qualities. This way of operating is not the call of Christ. Jesus wants more for us, and that *more* is to participate in his very life. It is a deeper, fuller, and more meaningful way of coming to know, love, and share Jesus with others. If we are truly his Body sacramentally, we are to really be that body in the world. This week let us resolve to participate more deeply in the Body of Christ by coming to understand more deeply our unique gift *and* call from God.

The Summa Theologiae, his last and, unfortunately, uncompleted work, deals with the whole of Catholic theology. The patron saint of teachers, theologians and students, St. Thomas Aquinas died in 1274. His life and the impact he had on the whole Church, however, remains alive today. ©LPi



SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM – Preparation for the Sacrament of Baptism involves special instruction for the parents. Please call the parish office preferably before the child is born for more information and to schedule a Baptism. BAPTISM SPONSORS: According to Canon Law, the sponsor must be a practicing Catholic who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation, at least 16 years old, active member of their parish and if married, they must be in a sacramental (valid) marriage. If two sponsors are chosen, there should be one male and one female. BAPTISM CLASS: If this is your first child OR there is a three-year gap from when you first took the class, both parents are required to attend the Baptism class. The Godparents are encouraged to attend if they are able. Baptism Classes are held every third Sunday of the month in the Holy Trinity café from 8:15 a.m. - 10:45 a.m. Continental breakfast is provided. Daycare may be available upon request. Registration deadline is the Tuesday before the class.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE – Contact the parish at least six months in advance of the anticipated wedding date. Couples should refrain from setting a firm date until they have talked to the Priest to discuss Marriage plans. At least one of the parties must be a registered, practicing Catholic member of our parish.
