AUGUST 7TH, 2022 - NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear friends,

One of my favorite sayings these days is, "Oh, the difference faith makes!" Faith is fundamental to the supernatural life. It is a gift from God, and it is a habitual, theological virtue. We exercise it and thereby grow in our faith in God. The reason this brief phrase has stuck in my mind lately is because when people live in faith, they live differently. It is evident to those around them, especially those who also believe. Faith allows a rational person to come to see the whole picture of reality. Faith in a community is contagious. Faith grants us the capacity to experience even now and evermore the life of God!



Today's second reading speaks powerfully about faith. In this reading from the Letter to the Hebrews, we hear somewhat of a roll call of the heroes of faith in the Old Testament. They are held up for accomplishing great things for God. But it's not just that faith produces good works. It's that by faith these deeds were performed. The faith *itself* accomplishes the good in and through us.

As I think back over this last year, I am extremely grateful to God to have had this time of formation with all of you. God is on the move at St. Michael and Holy Trinity Parishes. My heart has been touched deeply by your love, your prayers, your example, your generosity, and your friendship. But most of all, my heart is touched by your faith. Faith makes all the difference. God really does amazing things in us and through us when we have even the smallest seed of faith alive within us.

Thank you for receiving me into your lives and for teaching me how to be a priest. I will be forever grateful to have learned from you what it means to have the heart of Christ the Priest. Thank you for supporting my (at times crazy) ideas, joining small groups, attending my classes, supporting the Altar and Server Guilds, praying for and encouraging our young people, and for submitting yourselves humbly to Christ in the daily process of conversion. Indeed, all of these things and more show "*the evidence of things not seen*," namely the evidence of faith alive.

I would be remiss to not say a word of deep gratitude to Father Strand, even though he would not want me to take up bulletin space for it. Thank you, Father, for being a holy and dedicated priest. You are a man of deep faith and deep resolve to work for the salvation of souls. You have shown me how important it is to always do the right thing, even when it is misunderstood or unwanted. These parish communities are blessed by your leadership, and I am extremely grateful to have learned and served with you. Thank you for your care for me and your support in my formation.

I will miss all of you, but please be assured of my prayers as I continue my formation in Rome.

PARISH MEMBERSHIP - Families and single persons 18 years and older are to be registered at the parish in order to receive the service the Church offers to all members of our Parish Family. SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM - Preparation for the Sacrament of Baptism involves special instruction for the parents. Please call the parish office preferably before the child is born for more information and to schedule a Baptism. **BAPTISM SPONSORS:** *According to Canon Law, the sponsor must be a practicing Catholic who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation, at least 16 years old, active member of their parish and if married, they must be in a sacramental (valid) marriage. If two sponsors are chosen, there should be one male and one female.* **BAPTISM CLASS:** If this is your first child OR there is a three-year gap from when you first took the class, both parents are required to attend the Baptism class. The Godparents are encouraged to attend if they are able. **Baptism Classes** are held every third Sunday of the month in the Holy Trinity café from 8:15 a.m. - 10:45 a.m. Continental breakfast is provided. Daycare may be available upon request. **Registration deadline is the Tuesday before the class.**

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE - Contact the parish at least six months in advance of the anticipated wedding date. Couples should refrain from setting a firm date until they have talked to the Priest to discuss Marriage plans. **At least one of the parties must be a registered, practicing Catholic member of our parish.**
