Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we have one of the most important texts on the Eucharist in the bible, John 6:66. Leading up to this passage we hear how the Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus had said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you." Then in John 6:66 we hear that "As a result of this, many of his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him." What is interesting is that Jesus doesn't run after them and call them back. Why? Because Jesus meant what he said. He was speaking literally. Rather than running after his disciples what does he do instead? He turns to the twelve and asks them, "Are you going to leave me too?" Peter has no idea what Jesus just said. But, nonetheless, Peter looks at Jesus and says, "Master to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." Basically, Peter says, I have no idea what you just said. I have no idea how you are going to do this. But, where am I going to go? We've come to believe, and we are convinced that you are the holy one of God. Here is Peter saying Í have no idea how you are going to do this, but I trust you. Then, later at the Last Supper it was one of those aha moments for Peter. Oh my gosh, this is how you are doing this. You can really do this, in saying "take this and eat it. This is my body." "Take this and drink it. This is the chalice of my blood." For 1500 years until the reformation every single Christian believed that what happened on the altar was actually Jesus himself. That the Eucharist really is Jesus. The teaching of Jesus at times is hard for us too, but like Peter we need to walk by faith and believe.






