



### PASTOR'S CORNER



As we come through the time of transition, having seen Fr. Paul off to his new job in Washington D.C., having celebrated with Dcn. Courchaine after his ordination to the diaconate, about to see Dcn. Bowe off to his ordination to the priesthood and preparing to see Fr. Jordan off and welcome our new

priests, we realized that I never introduced myself to the parishes in a bulletin article.


For those who do not know me, my name is Nick Dhein. I am a seminarian for the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, studying at St. Francis de Sales Seminary, and currently on a Pastoral Year here at St. Monica and St. Eugene parishes. I am originally from Slinger, famous for the Speedway and Little Switzerland ski hill, though I am much more familiar with the racetrack. I have been with the parishes now for slightly over four months, and yet it often feels like it has been much longer because of how warmly you have welcomed me and brought me into the community.

I understand that many of you may not know what a Pastoral Year is, as it is not as common a part of the formation journey here as it is in other dioceses. The aim of both the Teaching Parish and Pastoral Year is to help form a man's pastoral skills of leadership and accompaniment through hands-on experience in the parish, as it is near impossible to learn in any other environment. The Teaching Parish is a way to weave this experience in with the academic life of the seminarian. The Pastoral Year intensifies this by removing the academic portion so that the sole focus of the man is how to live the life of the parish priest, and to develop pastoral skills through their practice.

The Pastoral Year, then, has a seminarian living in the rectory at a parish with the priest, or priests, assisting at the parish and shadowing the priest, when possible, in ministry. For me here at St. Monica and St. Eugene, this means that I live at the rectory at St. Monica, being part of the community there and learning from the priests how they live the life. I also assist at Mass and Baptisms most weekdays and weekends, unless an event draws me away, and accompany Father on visits and Anointing calls. Finally, it includes me spending time in the office, answering questions, meeting people, and assisting with various ministries within the parishes and schools, particularly in formation. It has been a great joy for me to be a part of most of the formation ministries, whether that be co-leading small groups for Confirmation and Teen Night, teaching some of the sixth graders on Thursday nights, spending time in the schools teaching about the Sacraments and accompanying various trips or helping with rehearsal and final preparation for Confirmation and First Communion.

The plan is for me to stay with the parishes through the summer and the fall semester, so that I will be here full-time until December. I hope to take full advantage of this opportunity by continuing to help with formation such as the Summer Confirmation program, as well as assisting with Liturgies and being available for whatever you need. Once December comes, I will go back to the academic life of the Seminary but will likely keep the parishes as my Teaching Parishes, and so my involvement would look much like it has with Dcn. Bowe and Dcn. Courchaine. In the meantime, feel free to stop by the office to talk, or you can call the office and get connected to me either through email or phone. This year has started well, and I am excited for what is yet to come.
