





Brothers and Sisters -

Over the past number of weeks we have heard from Deacon Matthew Bowe, Deacon Michael Courchaine, and Seminarian Nick Dhein. Each of them has shared a little bit about where they are in the process of

formation for the priesthood. Being a part of their journeys is an absolute joy for us. It gives us hope for the future of the Church. It gives us an insight into what preparation for the priesthood entails. It allows us to form friendships with them, helping to remind us of the humanity of the priest. For myself, it is especially consoling. These men, when ordained, will become my brothers. They will share the very same mission that all priests have committed their lives to; building up the Kingdom of God and working for the salvation of souls.

Sometimes when we speak about the priesthood we can emphasize the sacrifice. Especially the sacrifice of having a family. To give up the joy of marrying and having children. This is indeed a sacrifice. However, I've been a priest for three years now, and I gotta say, the joys that accompany the life of a priest are absolutely breathtaking. Celibacy is not just a sacrifice. It is also a gift given by the Lord. The gift to love with an open heart, freely and generously. To be tasked with developing an undivided heart for the Lord so as to be able to respond at any time and in any place to the needs of the faithful. To be asked to invite more and more and more people into your heart, just like Jesus. When I first was ordained, this was overwhelming. I remember feeling like my heart was being torn apart. Thanks be to God the Lord has since expanded my heart and revealed to me the mesmerizing beauty that the gift of celibacy offers in this pilgrimage of life. To be welcomed into your homes and gather around the dinner table with laughter; to stop in the classrooms of the school and see extraordinary faith in the wide eyes of the children; to celebrate Mass with living saints every morning; to hear vulnerable, contrite, and sincere confessions, exposing one's heart to the Lord; to be welcomed to your bedside or the bedside of those that you love in the hospital to offer an anointing, where the veil between Heaven and earth can be so thin; to meet for coffee or breakfast at City Market to talk about the simple everyday joys of life; to go for walks to talk

about faith by the Lakeshore. Of course, this is just the tip of the iceberg. But the extent to which I am able to live this extraordinary life with all of you is only possible because of the gift of celibacy. I can't tell you how many times I get into my car and laugh out loud because of how lucky I feel to be a priest.

One of the most powerful gifts of celibacy is to be able to draw close to those who are poor. Those who, for whatever reason, find themselves alone as well. Those who have struggled to find a partner for life, those who have lost a spouse through illness and death, those who have suffered abuse or a broken relationship. Some of the moments that have truly left me in awe have been when I have been able to express to those who are alone that they are not alone in their aloneness. That I am alone too. That we are together in this poverty.

A couple weekends ago there were six new men ordained to the priesthood. One of them is a dear friend of mine who joined the seminary the same year that I did. I had the honor of being able to travel to his hometown in Mexico for his Mass of Thanksgiving at his home parish last weekend. His joy for the new gift of priesthood only rekindled mine. One of the things that he expressed to all of us was, "This is the happiest day of my life. After the gift of life, the priesthood is the greatest gift that God has given me."

When you think of the priest, please do not think that it is a life that is solely sacrificial. Please do not pity us in our celibacy. Truly, it is one of the most extraordinary gifts that God has given us, and we are in awe each and every day that He has chosen us to receive it. Those that live this life form a unique brotherhood. A band of brothers, so to speak. For the young men reading this, perhaps God is calling you to join this brotherhood. Perhaps God is calling you to embrace the extraordinary gift of celibacy. Perhaps God is calling you to be a priest. Will you be one of our brothers?


