You take away our sins and help us to live as children of the Father. Christ, have mercy.

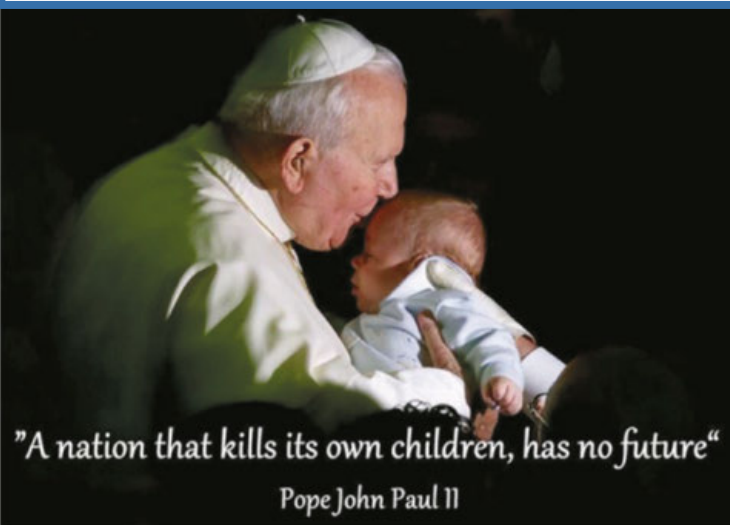
You constantly renew us through the gift of the Holy Spirit. Lord, have mercy.

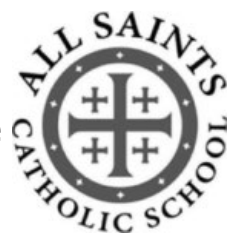

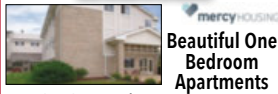

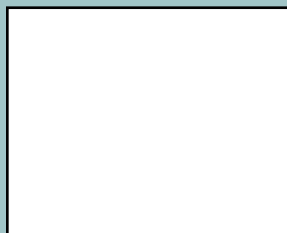
