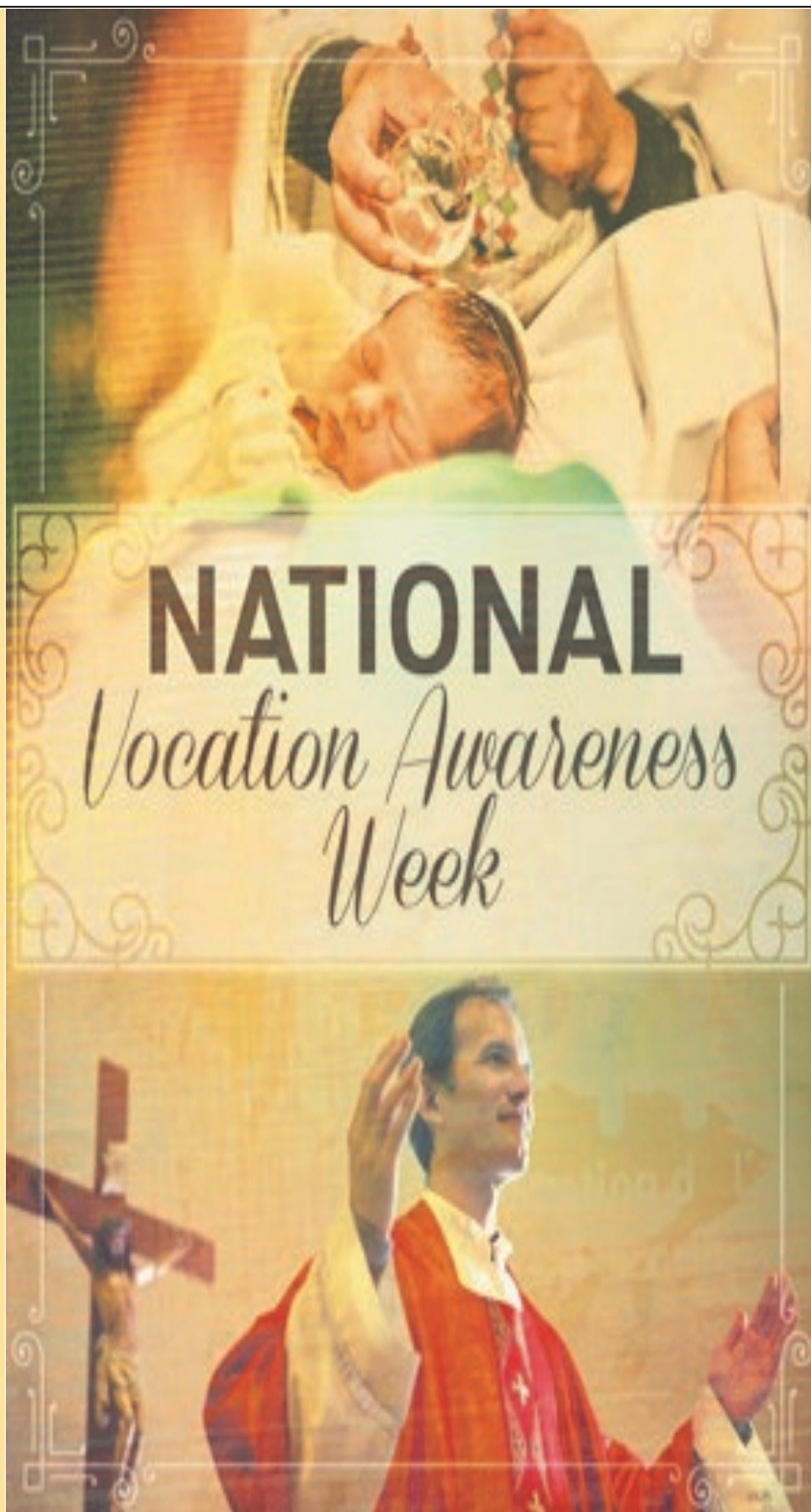

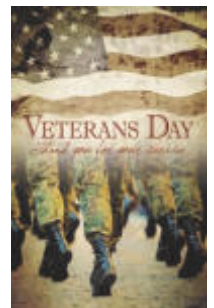

FROM THE SHARED PASTOR'S DESK

1.) This Weekend Daylight Savings Time Begins –
Let your clocks “fall back” an hour to be on time!

2.) Did You Know – You can satisfy all, or part, of your annual Required Minimum Distribution from your IRA by making gifts to **St. Peter Congregation** or **St. Peter Congregation Endowment Fund?**

3.) Needy Families for the Holidays – If you would like to help and reach out to a parish needy family, a gift in an envelope marked “Needy Families” will go toward a confidential purchase of SCRIP in a sufficient supply to provide for a generous celebration of Thanksgiving with leftovers for many a day to come. Please be generous if you are able; thank you!

4.) Universal Call to Holiness – The late Cardinal Francis George OMI of Chicago once said, “People who are holy, whether or not publically recognized by the Church as saints, keep the world from turning into hell.” When we think about the varied and many troubles of our time, we typically end up looking for solutions in terms of the next five-year plan, program, or round of elections, missing the forest for the trees. If we joyfully embraced our call to holiness and chose to live as attentively as our own particular states in life allow according to theological and cardinal virtues as well as evangelical counsels, our world could be far less hellish! As Fr. Jonathon reminded us in his series of articles, the theological virtues (faith, hope and love) put us in a life-giving graced relationship with the Holy Trinity, our every choice being mindful of God as our origin, motive & goal; that would definitely impact on behavior, decisions, and even conversations! Practicing of the cardinal virtues – prudence, temperance, justice and fortitude – would certainly diminish all too frequent “foot-in-mouth” social media postings, prevent substance abuse related weakness from diminishing self-control, help us put the common good before personal preferences, and teach us how to endure disappointment in the short term with the long view in mind. Practicing the evangelical counsels (recommended for all who seek holiness) – poverty, chastity, obedience – would help us be more generous, mindful, and humbly thoughtful, character traits that would go far to improve the present social climate. The sin(s) of our times can only be overcome by lives devoted to manifesting holiness: “Those who change the world for the better are holy; they transform it permanently, instilling in its energies love inspired by the Gospel! The saints are humanity’s great benefactors!” (Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI) Be yourself so resolved!!

5.) Veterans Day – Observances are a most welcome opportunity to show our appreciation for the men and women who have faithfully, heroically and willingly put their lives at the service of the good of “We, the People ...,” our great nation. My grandfather was a WWI

Part of their heroism is the humility with which the appreciation due is received. My father was offered a chance to attend an HONOR FLIGHT event and reluctant to do so. Why? Of course, age was a factor, but more importantly, at least to him, was that he did not sacrifice to the degree of many others wounded, disabled and deceased. WWII ended right before his Army group, basic training completed, would have been deployed for a long, bloody conflict to the bitter end for the unconditional surrender of Japan. As he had not to risk making the ultimate sacrifice, he felt others deserved more honors than he. Pray for all our veterans!
