**FROM THE SHARED PASTOR'S DESK**

**1.) Fr. Jonathon** – Is the first associate pastor ever assigned to St. Peter, Slinger and St. Lawrence, Hartford: Resurrection, Allenton had the experience of an associate pastor(s) when, as Sacred Heart, they shared responsibility for several smaller parishes prior to their merger in 1997. Typically, associate pastors are assigned for limited terms of office; when I was newly ordained my term was for up to six years and non-renewable so that we could have another assignment as an associate to broaden our experience before becoming pastors; younger priests prior to 1979 had 20 years in service before becoming a pastor; after 1979, due to the priest shortage, it was about 12 years; my first pastorate was in 11! Now young priests are told they may be called upon to assume a pastorate after 6 years and, in some cases, in as few as 3! This will be an emotional, exciting time for Fr. Jonathon, all of you and I; Archbishop ListECKI promised me that he would take good care of us in transition; I trust him and God to provide another good shepherd to help guide our active and growing flocks!

**2.) Saturday, January 22, 2022** – Is the Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children; consider beginning the day with Mass on Saturday morning, confession afterwards, and join the Church in a spirit of penance with fasting and/or making a charitable gift to pro-life causes in our community. As reviews are pending in our Supreme Court sometime this year, we pray it will take note that the vast majority of Americans for years have been opposed to the practice of abortion on demand, preferring it be allowed for infrequently and by way of exception when there is no other recourse. As this con-sensus has been growing, especially in our young adults, prayer can only add to the momentum necessary to undo what has been and is national tragedy. Could it be that a part of our current shortage of people for many jobs is, in some part, explainable due to millions of lives prematurely, our current inconveniences at least, in part, socially self-inflicted? Sin always has deleterious effects and involves usurping a divine authority; if God is the author of all life, then all life should be treated with the respect due the Creator's design and without imposition of our human standards.

**3.) Pro-Life Wisconsin** – Inaugurated an annual prayer card contest opportunity for Wisconsin K-12 students, encouraging use of their artistic talent to draw or paint an image representing "love for life;" 250 entries were received, and the winning entry is from a daughter of St. Peter's, Maria Graziano! A framed, large copy of her work will be on display in St. Peter Church hallway after Masses next weekend; prayer cards with it and a pro-life prayer written by yours truly on the back will be available. Great job, Maria!

**4.) Covid-19** – While there has been no outbreak from Mass attendance, we encourage the exercise of personal responsibility. Those who feel sick or take care of someone who is, those at risk of serious illness due to health complications or exposure, should stay home and watch

Sunday Mass on TV or social media live-stream until they feel comfortable returning in-person; their Sunday Mass attendance is excused.

**5.) Martin Luther King** – Is remembered this week for courageous preaching, activism and demonstration for the civil and human rights of African Americans, assassinated for his bold, necessary and now appreciated efforts. While not a canonized martyr, he is certainly in good company with Saints Agnes, Sebastian and Fabian whom the Church honors this week. Agnes refused arranged marriages, wanting to remain a virgin bride of Christ and to serve His people in that capacity; she was threatened, exposed naked in a brothel (a legend reports that her hair grew long enough to modestly cover her), and finally executed for her beliefs. Fabian was a Pope who made diplomatic efforts to mitigate persecution of the Church and was rewarded with martyrdom. Sebastian was a soldier when Roman military authorities thought it best to purge army ranks of Christians lest religious beliefs about not unnecessarily taking life interfere with the ruthlessness necessary for success; he was shot with arrows aimed at non-lethal areas so that he would slowly bleed to death, but rescued, he recovered and returned to upbraid the emperor for misconduct toward Christians; he was summarily executed. May the courageous conviction of the martyrs, canonized or not, inspire us!


