

FROM THE SHARED PASTOR'S DESK

- 1.) Lent Begins Ash Wednesday, March 2: "Come Back to Me with All Your Heart, Not Just a Part!" 2.) Our Annual Lenten Parish Mission – Begins Monday, March 07, through Wednesday, March 09; all sessions will be held at St. Lawrence Church, 4886 Hwy 175, Hartford; morning sessions begin with Mass @ 8AM followed by some social time with Mission presentation from 9-10:30AM; the evening sessions will be from 6:30-8PM with socials following. Fr. Jonathon and I will be offering the presentation of "Mass Explained," answering many questions gathered from parishioners at large, from Religious Education Program classes, Parish Committees and groups. Given amount and scope of questions, there is much more than enough to cover and promise very interesting sessions for ALL who attend. The morning and evening presentations will be the same with the same presenter(s), so if you have always wondered why what goes on at Mass does and what it all means, this Mission is for you from us!
- 3.) The Lenten Fast/Abstinence Rules Catholics over 14 years old must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent; those over 18 & under 59 should fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (this means only one full meal, and only liquids like milk or fruit juice between meals). One is excused from this obligation IF health or work would be SERIOUSLY affected.
- **4.)** Masses During the Cluster Parish Mission Will be at St. Lawrence, so there will not 8AM Mass on Monday @ St. Peter; Tuesday 8AM Mass is @ St. Lawrence as usual; Wednesday, 8AM Mass will be **both** @ St. Lawrence and St. Peter (due to Mass with St. Peter Catholic School Children); no Wednesday 6:30PM Mass @ Resurrection; thereafter, back to normal!
- 5.) St. Katherine Drexel Was born in 1858 @ Philadelphia, PA into an affluent family that did not wealth as means to power but as an opportunity to serve; Katherine remembered her father & step-mother (her own mother died when Katherine was 5 weeks old) opening their home to the poor three days every week, attending Mass and practicing ½ hour of mental prayer every day; these gave her a different perspective on social arrangements, leaving her quite uninterested in marriage or galas. At her father's death in 1885, she received one third of his very considerable estate which she decided should be applied to charity but was unsure how and where until she became aware of the plights of Native Americans and people of color. She established schools, including Xavier University in New Orleans which was among the first to admit peoples of color; she took exception to discrimination and segregation long before the Civil Rights Movement; by the time of her death in 1955 she'd founded 145 Catholic missions/schools for Native Americans and 50 for African Americans, shaping our Catholicism to serve all despite race, color or creed!

6.) Panhandling Incidents – As in Daily News: "The Slinger Police department is warning the public about panhandling incidents that occurred February 09 & 15. The female loiters outside churches and approaches people asking for money. She may be wearing a medical boot and using a crutch or cane. There may also be a male with her who has been seen waiting in a maroon SUV.
