

FOR CATHOLICS Today, misconception illness can prevent u

Today, misconceptions surrounding mental illness can prevent us from responding well to those suffering. This eight-session course explores the realities of mental illness, as well as the need for faith-based conversations about this topic. The sessions feature the stories of Catholics living with mental health challenges, along with the insights of archbishops, theologians, and psychologists.



FROM THE SHARED ASSOCIATE PASTOR'S DESK

This week we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Annunciation on March 25**, which is one of my favorite celebrations within the life of the Church. This day celebrates with great joy the moment when the archangel Gabriel appeared to our Blessed Mother and announced that she would conceive by the Holy Spirit and bring forth a son, who is Jesus.

We should consider the **creation of the world**. It might seem like a strange place to start our considerations. However, several of the early church fathers held the opinion that March 25 was the day that God created the world. While we can't get into why or how they came to this conclusion, their opinion has a more important *spiritual* truth. On March 25 at the Annunciation, Jesus takes on human flesh and begins to **re-create** the world through his incarnation. The early church fathers are looking to make a spiritual point by saying that on the same day of the year when God created the world, he also began to make it new through his Son Jesus coming into the world. We rejoice that he has come so close to our humanity as to make us whole and healthy again.

How can we celebrate this great occasion? We might commit ourselves to praying the **Angelus prayer** every day – at 6 AM., Noon and 6 PM – to remind ourselves throughout the day that God draws near to us. Just set a little alarm on your phone to remind you, or listen for the Church bells!

Here is the prayer for you:

V/ The angel of the Lord declared unto Mary; R/ And she conceived by the Holy Spirit.

Hail Marv...

V/ Behold the handmaid of the Lord.

R/ Be it done to me according to your word. *Hail Marv...*

V/ And the Word was made flesh.

R/ And dwelt among us.

Hail Mary...

V/ Pray for us, O holy Mother of God,

R/ That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Pour forth, we beseech you, O Lord, your grace into our hearts, that we, to whom the incarnation of Christ your Son, was made known by the message of an angel, may by his passion and cross be brought to the glory of his resurrection, through the same Christ our Lord. Amen
