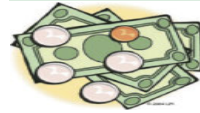

2ND SUNDAY OF EASTER, APRIL 24, 2022

FROM THE SHARED PASTOR'S DESK

- 1.) First Communion Masses** – Begin next weekend at our cluster parishes; children & their families will celebrate this wonderful Sacrament at regularly scheduled weekend Masses, receiving First Holy Communion over a period of several weekends; while this was necessary during Covid-19 restrictions, families actually found this more enjoyable and less stressful than organizing the large group or class celebrations, allowing children to focus more fully on receiving the Eucharist without excessive attention to external elements that can distract them from what is essential to the meaning of the day. Not having a separately special large group First Communion Mass stresses the importance of the regular gathering of faithful disciples every Sunday and holyday of obligation; parents who do everything else for their children will want to do this above all!
- 2.) Safe Environment Week** – Is observed throughout the Archdiocese of Milwaukee this week; I know full well how many of you hope we could sooner than later put the topic of clergy sexual misconduct behind us, but what we prematurely put out of view is also too quickly put out of mind as well. History teaches that when we're not persistently mindful of unfortunate past or tragic events, the likelihood of something terrible happening again, despite best intentions to the contrary, is heightened because forgetfulness leads to lack of vigilance, creating a vacuum for what we do not wish to ever happen again to do exactly that! Pray for victims, perpetrators, law enforcement & social workers, coordinators of safe environment programs that protect us, especially our children, youth & other vulnerable individuals in every public and private space; let's not give in to the temptations of forgetfulness!
- 3.) St. Mark** – Is commemorated Monday, April 25; his is, historically speaking, the earliest of those four written accounts of the earthly life and ministry of Jesus Christ we call Gospels. In his early teens during Jesus' ministry, he became a disciple of Paul and later Peter. An early church father says that Mark, after the deaths of Peter and Paul, put into writing the things that Peter had said in testimony to Jesus, beginning with His baptism in the Jordan River by John the Baptist (he has no Christmas stories), concluding with the Lord's Ascension; his account was known to Matthew and Luke, forming the basis for their more extensive gospels, as well as to John as he wrote the last gospel. As Mark's gospel is the shortest and most simply worded, I recommend you read it this week as an appropriate post-Easter spiritual exercise!
- 4.) Administrative Professionals Day** – Is Wednesday, April 27. Day to day ministry in our 3 cluster parishes would not be as possible or smooth without the capable services of our secretaries and bookkeepers; these wonderful women make things work for everyone! Please join me prayerful gratitude for Linda (@ Resurrection), Nancy (@ St. Lawrence), Donna, Kim, Rita & Yvonne (@ St. Peter); they're all treasures; if you see any one/all of them this week, add your thanks to mine!
