BANNS OF MARRIAGE

FROM THE SHARED ASSOCIATE PASTOR'S DESK

Please note that Father Rick and I will be gone from the parishes from May 2-4 for the annual **Spring Priest Assembly**. Due to its cancellation the previous two years, this will only be second time attending for me. Sister Miriam James Heidland, SOLT will speak on the theme "The Heart of the Priesthood". I look forward to spending some time with the Archbishop and the other priests of the Archdiocese.

Today is the **Third Sunday of Easter**. The Gospel (John 21:1-19) for the Mass today is, by far, my favorite passage in all the scriptures. I'd like to highlight a few details in the story.

First, in John 21:12, Jesus says to the disciples, "Come, have breakfast." Jesus said many important, necessary and comforting words, but are there many words in our world more comforting than "Come, have breakfast." But, on a serious note, it reminds us that our Lord has a care even for the practical things – like his disciples needing to eat and be nourished for the work ahead.

Second, we hear Jesus' questioning of Peter. Three times Jesus asks him, "Do you love me more than these? Do you love me? Do you love me?" In the course of the interrogation, Peter becomes slightly agitated at being asked three times because he desires to love Jesus and express it. Much could be (and has been) written about this passage. Many authors have pointed out that Jesus three-fold questioning "Do you love me?" is to undo Peter's three-fold denial of Jesus during his arrest and crucifixion.

All of these aside, our Lord this Sunday asks us the same question: Do you love me? What is our response? Do we love Jesus? Do we love Jesus to the point of giving our lives if it is asked of us? (After Peter re-confesses his love for Jesus, he is told that he will die a martyr's death). Do we show such ardent and devoted love for Jesus in our lives? Through outward actions? Through kind words? Through habits of prayer and sacrifice? Jesus asks each of us: Do you love me? What will our response be?


