
### **BANNS OF MARRIAGE**

#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

- 1.) In the Theater A major movie was released April 13 called FR. STU; it is unflinchingly honest, funny and uplifting, the true story of a lost soul who finds his purpose in the most unexpected place: the priesthood! Not for the faint of heart (rated R for objectionable language, violence, and adult content), the rough and tumble profanity of Fr. Stu's pre-conversion life portrays the struggles of a street guy from a broken family trying to make it, find himself, & discovering the Lord wants him to be His servant. Considering the R rating, both the Bishop of Las Vegas (NV) who ordained him and the Bishop of the Helena (MT) where he served, endorse and encourage seeing the movie, esp. priests and seminarians, men over age 18, college students and young adults because it doesn't water down the faith or the reality of what life looks like when you're trying to find your way. FR. STU is a raw, unfiltered, combative, grace-filled witness that no one is ever beyond redemption; I saw it; it was moving; if you missed it, consider seeing it! 2.) 2022 Catholic Stewardship Appeal – Reports that we're already well over goal of \$58,710 with \$77,726 raised by 193 donors or about 14.5% of our membership; with additional donors new and old discerning participation, success is assured; Archdiocesan wide the Appeal has already received \$4,077,427 toward a goal \$8.1 million from 15,839 donors for a truly generous quick start, maybe among the best starts in recent memory – thank you ever so much!
- 3.) Our Lady of Fatima The apparitions of Our Lady to three shepherd children (Lucia, Francisco & Jacinta) which occurred six times between May 13 – October 13 in 1917 were completed as she announced herself to be Our Lady of the Holy Rosary and called for the amendment of people's lives; then, on a wet and dismal day, the sun suddenly appeared and seemed to tremble, rotate violently, and finally fall, dancing over the heads of those gathered before it returned to normal; this "miracle of the sun" was repeated twice more! While the apparition has been approved by the Church, not all subsequent revelations and devotions have been submitted to the same and very exacting process, resulting in controversy over interpretations of promises and secrets that are associated; one of the seers herself was mistaken in interpretation of a promise that seemed to indicate WWI would end October 13, 1917 (it ended November 11, 1917); a number of other matters of secondary importance have not always concurred with testimony by the seers with a result in controversy and disagreements among adherents and the misuses of the apparitions in attempts to predict the how and the when of the end of the world, something scripture testifies that Jesus Himself said is known to God alone. While some have alleged signs of the world's end for a variety of reasons over a number of years, Jesus clearly said that no one knows when; the Church has no teaching whatsoever about the specific time or the events that might accompany it; the end of the world Jesus encourages us to prepare for well is NOT the day the world burns up, but the day each one of us dies and leaves it.


