

Dear Parishioners,
I open with BBB! The Feb – June schedule is on flyers in the back. Next meeting is for FAT TUESDAY on March 4th, 7PM at St. Lawrence. The theme is Mardi Gras and a Potluck Celebration of smoked foods and stews and any sides. Bring your best!

There was a man named Dale Carnegie who wrote a book in 19?? entitled, “How to Win Friends and Influence People.” It’s ranked 7th on the list of bestselling American books. It has sold over 30 million copies and continues to sell over 250,000 copies each year. The premise of the book is summed up on one quote:

“The world is full of people who are grabbing and self-seeking. So the rare individual who unselfishly tries to serve others has an enormous advantage.”

Carnegie pushes the old carrot versus the stick method of motivation and he explores it to its fullest! He tries to get his reader to be different from the way the world attempts to operate and goes over its multitudes of failures. He then lays out a different path. He implores his audience to seek alliances rather than adversaries, arguing that the way to get people’s cooperation is through honest interest and understanding rather than a contest. He explains:

“Why talk about what we want? That is childish. Absurd. Of course, you are interested in what you want. You are eternally interested in it. But no one else is. The rest of us are just like you: we are interested in what we want.”

I often think of Dale Carnegie when I read some of Jesus’s teachings such as turning the other cheek and, taking the beam out of one’s own eye... and loving your enemies. Obviously Jesus’ teaching was much more expansive than what Dale Carnegie offers but his mega-popular book does prove one thing. People know the truth of these words and their soul craves them be they from Jesus or Dale Carnegie.
