ST. PETER CANISIUS | FEAST DAY DECEMBER 21

Born in Holland, St. Peter Canisius (May 8, 1521 – December 21, 1597) was a preacher, teacher, and writer throughout his whole life. At the age of 19, he received a master's degree from the university at Cologne. Soon afterwards, St. Peter met Peter Faber, the first disciple of Ignatius of Loyola, who influenced him so much that he eventually joined the Society of Jesus. St. Peter Canisius founded colleges and seminaries, served as a missionary, cared for the sick or imprisoned, and wrote close to eight volumes of letters — many about St. Cyril of Alexandria and St. Leo the Great. A man blessed with many talents, St. Peter Canisius is a wonderful example of a man who developed his talents to further God's work here on earth.



The History of the Papacy --- Article 12

Last week we began to look at the earliest list of the bishops of Rome, given by Irenaeus, the bishop of Lyons (France) from 177 to 202 AD. In his great work titled "Against Heresies", written to refute various "gnostic" ideas corrupting the faith in the 2nd century, Irenaeus emphasized the notion of "apostolic succession" as the surest guide to authentic Christian teaching and leadership. According to this developing doctrine, true leaders and teachers of the faith must be able to trace their appointment and ordination back to the apostles. To illustrate this, Irenaeus gives us the earliest list of the bishops of Rome up to his own time: Linus, Cletus, Clement, Evaristus, Alexander, Sixtus, Telesphorus, Hyginus, Pius, Anicetus, Soter, and Eleutherus. We've already discussed Clement, Pius, Anicetus, and Soter in connection with some other early Christian writings in the 2nd century, so let's focus on other aspects of Irenaeus' list.



First of all, notice he does not place Peter as the first bishop of Rome, for he and Paul were considered primarily as traveling APOSTLES rather than resident bishops. Secondly, notice that Irenaeus lists a total of TWELVE bishops of Rome from the beginning up to his own time, and the sixth is named Sixtus. Many scholars believe that Irenaeus may have adapted and expanded an earlier list recorded by the church of Rome itself in order to create a parallel between the first twelve bishops of Rome and the twelve apostles. The first two names, Linus and Cletus, had never been mentioned before Irenaeus, so where did he get this info? We don't really know, but at the end of Paul's 2nd Letter to Timothy in the New Testament, a certain Linus is mentioned by Paul as being with him in Rome shortly before his martyrdom (circa 65 AD). Is this the same Linus who would become the first bishop of Rome after Peter's martyrdom? Possibly. It's interesting that while Cletus is not mentioned in the New Testament, the next name on the list, Clement, is mentioned by Paul in his letter to the Philippians (4:3) as being one of his missionary co-workers, so this may be the same man.

Recall the evidence we explored in previous articles that the early church in Rome was led by a council of presbyters, and that it probably didn't adopt the single-bishop model until the mid-2nd century. By listing the "bishops" of Rome from its beginnings, Irenaeus seems to be retrojecting into an earlier period the more developed Roman hierarchy of the late 2nd century. Given the rapid growth of the Christian population in the city of Rome, it is understandable why the church there shifted to a more centrally organized model of leadership. Scholars estimate that by the year 200 AD there were about 50,000 Christians in the city, out of a total population of about 1,000,000 (that's about 5%). While the Emperor Nero conducted a local persecution of Christians in Rome circa 65 AD (in which Peter & Paul were martyred), that was because he saw them as an easy scapegoat for the fire that devastated the city at that time. After Nero, most of the subsequent emperors tolerated Christians, though local persecution did sometimes occur. Even some prominent members of the upperclass nobility in Rome became Christian, and the church gained some influence in the city. In the year 195, Bishop Victor convinced the emperor's mistress, Marcia, herself a Christian, to use her influence to secure the release of some fellow Christians imprisoned on the island of Sardinia. It wasn't until the middle of the 3rd century, circa 250 AD, that the first empire-wide persecution of Christians was decreed by an emperor. It was then that the church had to function in a more secretive way in Rome, meeting and worshipping "underground" in the catacombs (which were burial chambers for the dead.)

During the reign of the next bishop of Rome, Zephyrinus (199-217), a presbyter named Gaius mentions that believers came from all over to visit the "trophies" (or monuments) of Peter and Paul. This is probably the earliest reference to some type of shrine built on or near the spots where these two great apostles were buried. The shrine of Peter was built on the slope of Vatican Hill, which at the time was on the outskirts of the city, while the shrine of Paul was on the southern edge of the city. Interestingly, when Pope Pius XI died in 1939, workers refurbishing the papal crypts under St. Peter's Basilica uncovered what looked like a small niche or shrine. Since this was directly under the high altar of the church above, it seems that when the church was rebuilt in the 1500's the architect (Michelangelo for a time) took great care in locating the altar where it is. The obvious explanation for this is that the ancient shrine directly under the altar was that of none other than St. Peter himself. Workers also uncovered some bones near the shrine, and after years of secretive study Pope Paul VI declared them to be the very bones of St. Peter, "identified in a way that we consider convincing". Many archeologists dispute this claim and the Vatican has never allowed a public examination of the evidence, though in 2013 Pope Francis displayed for the first time to the public the case which holds the bone fragments.


