

Many of you are probably still cleaning up and packing after Christmas. We spend Thanksgiving to Christmas eve



Recently, Archbishop Listecki addressed the issue of the significant increase in COVID cases. At St. Theresa, our COVID protocols include designated pews for social distancing, conveniently located hand sanitizers, and extra cleaning. We currently have 5 pews designated for social distancing. Catholic Charities: 60 wishes granted to needy kids and adults in the


Supported Parenting Program
