From our Parochial Administrator

Dear Parishioners of Holy Cross,

Happy Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph!

In January of 1964, Pope St. Paul VI made history by becoming the first pope since St. Peter himself to go to the Holy Land (he also became the first pope to go on an airplane on that trip!). Among many reasons, he made this journey to experience the spiritual riches that countless other pilgrims have received by visiting the holy sites of salvation history, so as to bring these fruits back to his ministry in Rome as the Second Vatican Council was still underway.

In a visit to Nazareth, the home of the Holy Family, the saintly pope said in a special address, "How I would like to return to my childhood and attend the simple yet profound school that is Nazareth! How wonderful to be close to Mary, learning again the lesson of the true meaning of life, learning again God's truths." He went on to share three lessons that can be learned from the example of the humble home of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph: silence, family life, and the discipline of work.

Regarding silence, he notes that "we need this wonderful state of mind, beset as we are by the cacophony of strident protests and conflicting claims so characteristic of these turbulent times. The silence of Nazareth should teach us how to meditate in peace and quiet, to reflect on the deeply spiritual, and to be open to the voice of God's inner wisdom."

The Holy Family, in Paul VI's reflection, shows us the "holy and enduring character" of the family itself, which has a "basic function in society: a communion of love and sharing, beautiful for the problems it poses and the rewards it brings."

Finally, the Holy Family helps us to see the value and purpose of work. "I would remind everyone that work has its own dignity. On the other hand, it is not an end in itself...I express my deep regard for people everywhere who work for a living. To them I would point out their great model, Christ their brother, our Lord and God, who is their prophet in every cause that promotes their well-being."

This Holy Family Sunday, let's all look to Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, to guide and intercede for our own families, that as we pursue the virtues and values which the home of Nazareth exemplifies, our own families may truly be "a communion of love."




