# From our Parochial Administrator

"There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone."

1 Corinthians 12:4-6

Dear Parishioners of Holy Cross,

In the Second Reading from Mass this Sunday, St. Paul urges the newly formed Christian community in Corinth to recognize the diversity of gifts that the Holy Spirit has bestowed upon them for the cause of the Gospel and for the sake of the unity of the Church. The various gifts he delineates in this passage are called "charisms" in the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

It states that charisms are "graces of the Holy Spirit which directly or indirectly benefit the Church, ordered as they are to her building up, to the good of men, and to the needs of the world." The Catechism continues to teach that these gifts should be welcomed and accepted, while at the same time always be discerned carefully by the shepherds of the Church, to ensure they are authentic promptings of the Holy Spirit and are in keeping with charity, "the true measure of all charisms."

It is so important for us to remember - the Holy Spirit is not asleep, He is hard at work! He is constantly bestowing gifts upon the faithful, not just for their own benefit, but for the good of the Church. Take time this week in prayer to ask the Holy Spirit, "What gifts have you given me? What gifts do you desire to give me?" Understand that, so long as these gifts are authentic and ordered toward charity and the unity of the Church, He wants you to use them!







# Batavia City-Wide Alpha


Alpha is a series of sessions exploring the Christian faith, typically run over eleven weeks. Each talk looks at a different question about life and
