# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear Friends in Christ,

Last week in Appleton, I started the Encounter School of Ministry in Appleton. The first quarter focuses on our identity. Our identity is rooted in Sonship. We are created in the image and likeness of God. We are beloved sons and daughters of our Heavenly Father. Too often we become stuck in a performance-based mentality. The enemy tells us that we need to do something in order to have something and finally become someone. The fact is, we already are someone by nature. You can be nothing greater than a child of God. I'm proud of our staff and volunteer catechists. As we mark this Catechetical Sunday, let us pray that together we will all be a learning community of disciples of Jesus Christ.

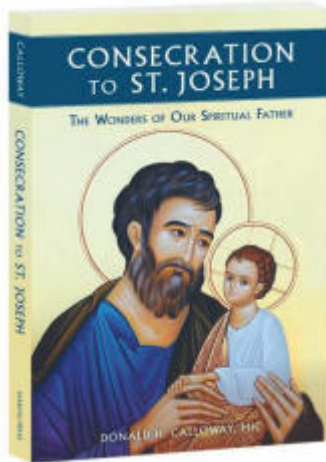

### CATECHETICAL SUNDAY: "SAY THE WORD AND MY SOUL SHALL BE HEALED"

Catechetical Sunday is a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the role that each person plays, by virtue of Baptism, in handing on the faith and being a witness to the Gospel. This year, the Church celebrates Catechetical Sunday on September 19th, and the theme is: "Say the Word and My Soul Shall be Healed." **Please keep our catechists and their families in your prayers as we embark on the new school year!**

### READING THROUGH THE BIBLE IN 90 DAYS

Have you always wanted to take up a Bible study, but don't have the time? The patience? A babysitter? Well, now is your chance to do what you have always dreamed of—reading through the Bible!

Over the next few months, there will be a reading guide in the vestibule of the church. This Ascension Press guide leads you through only the historical books of the Bible that cover our salvation history, so many supplemental books have been left out. Each day you will have only about four pages to read. It's an easy way to understand our salvation history, without going through the difficult passages on who begat whom! You will find it easy to follow and easy to do.

If you begin the readings around September 25th, you can finish by Christmas Eve. Or, if you prefer a Lenten study vs. an Advent Study, you could start on Ash Wednesday, March 2nd, and finish on Pentecost Sunday, June 5th. That's 40 days of Lent plus 50 days of Easter!

Our Parish Bible Study, "Epic, A Journey through Church History" also is a great way to look further into our faith. Classes began Monday and Tuesday, September 13 and 14. Choose the Monday or Tuesday evening study, 6:30 to 8:30, or mix and match as your schedule allows. No need to register; just come on by and see how it works! You can do the study with or without the workbook, choosing to enjoy the educational videos.

Both of these studies are part of our "Go Make Disciples" initiative of the Diocese. We hope you will plan to participate in one or both of them!

### JEFFERSON COUNTY RURAL LIFE LISTENING SESSION WITH BISHOP HYING: THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 23RD

Calling Jefferson County Farmers, gardeners, cheese-makers, rural health-care workers, interested rural community members and all who value the food, fuel and fiber produced within our county to an opportunity to share in a rural community dialogue with our Bishop Donald Hying. The third Diocese of Madison Rural Life Listening Session will be held on Thursday, September 23rd at St. Bernard Parish (114 S Church St., Watertown) from 7-9pm and represents all communities within Jefferson County.

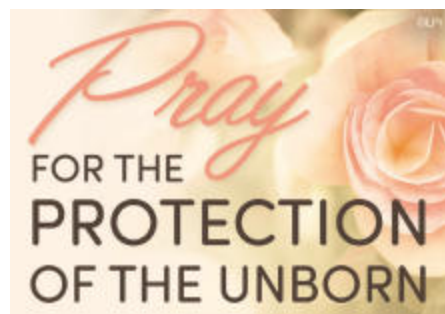


