2020 Missionary Cooperation Plan—MCP

As you know, each summer the Mission Office of our Archdiocese arranges for a couple of missionaries to visit our parish for a weekend. This year, in light of the global pandemic of COVID-19, these appeals are being featured on the MISSIO Fundraising Platform of the Pope's mission societies, MISSIO.org. Our parish has been assigned the Notre Dame Global Missions Ministry, the work of the Sisters of Notre Dame of Chardon.
