Putting Our Faith into Action **Catholic Relief Services (CRS)**

Ensuring Conditions for Vulnerable Children to Survive and Thrive is Critical to Our World's Future. Toward that end, Congress has introduced *The Global Child Thrive Act* (H.R. 4864 and S. 2715), with bipartisan support. A 2016 article in *The Lancet* entitled "Early childhood development: the foundation of sustainable development", estimates 250,000,000 children in low- and middle-income countries suffer suboptimal development due to poverty and stunting alone; and children who do not meet developmental milestones are expected to lose about 25% of their average yearly income as adults. *The Global Child Thrive Act*, if passed by Congress and signed into law, would integrate Early Childhood Development into development and emergency humanitarian programs serving vulnerable children and their families, helping them recover from the COVID-19 virus and building their resilience to future emergencies and trauma. The bill does not call for additional funding, just a small modification of current foreign aid programs that serve young children to ensure greatest impact. Learn more at <https://bit.ly/3iloLOS>.

Catholic Charities to help People of Lebanon

As you have already heard on August 4, a massive explosion rocked the city of Beirut, Lebanon, injuring more than 5,000 and killing more than 200. Officials are still evacuating residents, while trying to grasp the cost in human life and misery.

Along with Caritas Lebanon, Catholic Relief Services is distributing emergency supplies, clearing rubble, and preparing medical and mental health teams for dispatch.

Archbishop Jose H. Gomez, President of the USCCB, sent a memo to all US Bishops, expressing great concern for our brothers and sisters in Beirut and the terrible suffering of those impacted by the tragic explosion.


Archbishop Gomez encouraged dioceses to consider joining the effort in responding to this tragic event through prayer and donations. Archbishop Thompson also encourages parishes to have a second collection for the recovery efforts in Lebanon. The cathedral will have our collection Sept 5 and 6.
