## Do you miss Sunday Mass?

Has it been several months since you were last at your parish of SS. Peter & Paul Cathedral? Are you still not sure if you should return yet? Let me tell you what you will find at the Cathedral if you return:

- \* Enter only from the N. Meridian St. door.
- \* Sign your name on our attendance form.
- \* Hand sanitizer and face masks are available on the table there in the narthex if you didn't bring your own.
- \* Everyone who comes for Mass must wear a mask.
- \* We now have the Cathedral set up with 240 chairs all in groups of two. This set up is to accommodate several Confirmations that are scheduled here till the middle of November.
- \* Communion is only distributed by the presider who will wear a mask.
- \* Communion procession is by social distance following two large squares behind person in front.
- \* Exit is through either front or back doors.
- \* All kneelers are left in the down position so the hospitality ministers know which chair to sanitize.
- \* If you would like to visit the Cathedral for a daily Mass at 5:15pm, we follow the same procedures.



## Respect Life Sunday Mass

SS. Peter & Paul Cathedral will be the location of the Annual Respect Life Sunday Mass on October 4, 2020 at 10:30am. Archbishop Charles Thompson will be the presider.

The Central Indiana Life Chain that normally follows the Respect Life Mass will not be held this year.

After much deliberation and prayer and with the health and safety of Life Chain table leaders and participants of paramount importance, the Central Indiana Life Chain Leadership Team has decided to cancel the 2020 Life Chain event, which was to be held along North Meridian Street in Indianapolis on Respect Life Sunday, October 4.

We ask that all who would typically participate in the annual Central Indiana Life Chain consider offering one hour of personal or family prayer at home or in your church on Respect Life Sunday, praying for an end to abortion in our city, country, and in the world. Please pray for a conversion of heart for all those who support the abortion industry and for all those considering an abortion. Please also include prayers for those who have experienced the pain and loss caused by an abortion, whether personally or in their family, and also pray that those facing an unplanned or crisis pregnancy would choose life for their child.
