Issue: Faithful Citizenship

All believers are called to faithful citizenship, to become informed, active, and responsible participants in the political process. Every act of responsible citizenship is an exercise of significant individual power. Every voice matters in the public forum. Every vote counts.

Romans 13:5: Therefore, it is necessary to be subject not only because of the wrath but also because of conscience.

We encourage all citizens, particularly Catholics, to embrace their citizenship not merely as a duty and privilege, but as an opportunity meaningfully to participate in building the culture of life. Every act of responsible citizenship is an exercise of significant individual power. We must exercise that power in ways that defend human life, especially those of God's children who are unborn, disabled, or otherwise vulnerable.
