## Putting Our Faith into Action Catholic Relief Services (CRS)

CRS Responds to Explosion in Lebanon. Hosting over 1 million Syrian refugees while battling the COVID-19 pandemic, Lebanon was already suffering from economic and healthcare crises. Then, on August 4, a massive explosion rocked Beirut, injuring more than 5,000, killing more than 220, while destroying areas of the city and leaving an estimated 300,000 people homeless. CRS and 15 other faith-based partners are working to meet the significant needs of the people impacted by this disaster. With widespread damage, there is continuing need for shelter, medication, hygiene kits, counseling and debris clearing. Along with Caritas Lebanon, CRS is distributing emergency supplies, clearing rubble and ensuring mobile medical units and trauma support are available for those who need it most.
