

CHOICE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM & SGO GRANT

We are writing you with exciting news! In the recently passed state budget, Governor Holcomb and the Indiana General Assembly made educational options more affordable for families across our state. Starting with the 2021-22 school year, students of Hoosier families whose household income is 300% of Federal Free or Reduced-Price Meals guidelines or less now qualify to receive financial aid to help cover the cost of private school tuition. House Bill 1001 also provides all families receiving a Choice Voucher for the 2021-22 at the 90% level (instead of the 50% and 70% level). This will not take place until July 1st. If the amount of your child’s school voucher award changes from the original application, you will be notified after July 1st and new documentation will need to be signed.
