

Dear friends in Christ,

This week, as we begin the month of June, I will begin my summer work assisting with the One Bread, One Cup program at Saint Meinrad Archabbey. The annual One Bread, One Cup conferences provide liturgical formation and training for high school youth, who are assisted by a group of college ministerial interns. Our parish Coordinator of Evangelization and Discipleship, Brittney White, served as a college intern with the program a few years ago, and we had youth from our parish participate in 2019 and again this summer.

My role in the program has been to serve as Director of Liturgy – a role that I have had in some capacity since 2016. This summer, I will be working with two of the three five-day conferences as well as with the college interns. What this means for the parish is that there will be some blocks of time when I will be at Saint Meinrad over the next six weeks, and so our weekday Mass schedule will be adjusted during that time. If you regularly join us for Mass on weekdays, be sure to check the bulletin between now and mid-July for the weekly schedule. I’ll always be back here at Nativity for the weekends (with one exception, when we have a missionary priest visiting us), and usually for a few days each week, and I’ll be in regular contact with our parish staff throughout this time.

I believe strongly in the work that Saint Meinrad does in the formation of our young people in liturgy and prayer, and I believe we will continue to see the fruit of this program in our parish in the years to come.

VISITING MISSIONARY

The weekend of **June 12/13** we will host a missionary priest from the Archdiocese of Imphal, India. This Mission archdiocese covers the entire state of Manipur on the Indi-Myanmar border in Northeast India. It has a population of over 3.2 million. As of 2001, the Catholic population has grown to over 100,000 in 45 parishes and 5 mission centers. Being a mission diocese, we are not able to generate the much-needed funds to provide infrastructure in parishes that are opened every year. Though our tribal communities are poor, they are very hardworking and generous in providing locally available building materials like boulders, timber, stone chips and labor for construction work. You participation in the 2021 Missionary Cooperative Plan will help our diocese to realize the dream of the newly formed catholic community in Kamjon village. Currently, they gather in a small shed which needs to be replaced with a permanent church building. We kindly request you to participate in this small project by your generous support and prayers. You are assured of our love and prayers.



LIFTING OF THE DISPENSATION

from the Obligation of Mass
Effective June 11, 2021

The celebration of the Eucharist at Mass is the source and summit of our life and mission as Catholics.

As of March 2020, due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic, all Roman Catholics throughout the entire Province of Indianapolis, which comprises all five dioceses of Indiana, have been dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. However, with the decrease of cases in our state, the widespread availability of vaccines and following the guidance of public health officials, we are now able to safely accommodate more parishioners for Masses. Therefore, effective June 11, the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass is hereby lifted throughout the state of Indiana.

Except for the unique situations as described below, those who are otherwise healthy are obliged to return to Sunday Mass by the weekend of June 12-13, 2021:

- Those who are seriously ill, exhibit flu-like symptoms and/or may have a contagious disease (including quarantine due to exposure).
- Those who are unable to attend Mass through no fault of their own (e.g. transportation issue).
- Those who are homebound and/or incapacitated due to age, infirmity and/or medical restrictions.
- Those who have compromised health conditions and/or at high risk of contracting the virus.
- Those who are caretakers of person who are sick or of persons at high-risk of serious illness if they contract Covid virus.

If you have any questions about any specific needs, concerns or protocols, you are advised to contact Fr. Eric. As your pastor, he has the authority to dispense in individual cases and may be helpful in addressing individual fears and concerns.

The obligation to attend Mass is a joyful one, reflecting the very character of who we are as Catholics.

PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY


