

Dear friends in Christ,

In this past Friday's email Communique, we shared a joint letter from myself and the pastors of St. Jude and St. Mark parishes letting all of our parishioners know about a new season of collaboration and support that our three parishes are embarking on. One aspect of that collaboration is coordinating our weekend and Holy Day Mass schedules in such a way that if one of the three of us priests gets sick or is called away at the last minute, the other two could cover all Masses for the three parishes. We anticipate this being a rare – if ever – occurrence, but it is good to have schedules and plans in place for such a possibility.

Here at Nativity, we are not planning any change to our weekend or Holy Day Mass schedule – the times we currently have are able to fit in with the new schedules at St. Jude and St. Mark. Moving forward, our three parishes will continue to collaborate and support one another in ways that best make sense for the flourishing of our communities. This is not a merger or in any way a loss of parish identity. But it is good for us to be in open conversation and dialogue so that all of our parish communities can best live out our mission to be the presence of Christ and his Church in the southeastern part of Indianapolis.

NATIVITY ST. VINCENT DE PAUL CONFERENCE

Nativity St. Vincent de Paul Fiscal 2020-2021 2nd, 3rd Quarter Recap

Our Nativity SVDP conference team just completed its fiscal 3rd quarter on June 30th. This summary will cover quarters 2 and 3, which ran from Jan 1st - June 30th, 2021. Requests for help during this period was not as sweeping as we feared it might be. We heard requests from 24 families for assistance, which included at least 37 adults and 20 children. Below is a breakdown of our activity:

Overwhelmingly, the biggest request was for financial assistance from 17 of the families. We were able to help with about \$2,500 towards rent and utilities. Where we were not able to help directly, we did direct them to the appropriate non-profit or agency and do continue to work in conjunction with the Franklin Township Trustee many times.

Our home visitors also did virtual visits with 7 families and helped them by providing for their immediate needs including:


- Kroger gift cards in most cases to supplement basic shortages Purchasing a refurbished washer/dryer for 2 families and replaced a dryer for another.
- Donating 3 beds, with frames to 2 families in need. Providing miscellaneous items from Mission 27 warehouse including clothing, 4 mattresses, food processor.
- Helping a single parent family who was starting over by completely furnishing an apartment with a combination of donated furniture from Nativity parishioners, purchasing sheets, towels, etc. and delivering items from Mission 27 warehouse.
- We were also able to continue to provide financial support to the Good Shepherd SVDP conference (which has a much greater need than ours) with \$2,400 during this time period.

There is a regular pick-up at our 2 bins in the church parking lot which gets donated items to our Mission 27 store.

We started a Changing Lives program in February, but had to cancel because several in the class were unable to continue and we will plan to restart early in 2022. In April, our SVDP team organized a Nativity work day at the Mission 27 warehouse and will plan to do so again in the fall. Thank you for your prayers and support.

Aftercare Assistants Needed Next Year



LIFTING OF THE DISPENSATION

from the Obligation of Mass
Effective June 11, 2021

The celebration of the Eucharist at Mass is the source and summit of our life and mission as Catholics.

As of March 2020, due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic, all Roman Catholics throughout the entire Province of Indianapolis, which comprises all five dioceses of Indiana, have been dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. However, with the decrease of cases in our state, the widespread availability of vaccines and following the guidance of public health officials, we are now able to safely accommodate more parishioners for Masses. Therefore, effective June 11, the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass is hereby lifted throughout the state of Indiana.

Except for the unique situations as described below, those who are otherwise healthy are obliged to return to Sunday Mass by the weekend of June 12-13, 2021:

- Those who are seriously ill, exhibit flu-like symptoms and/or may have a contagious disease (including quarantine due to exposure).
- Those who are unable to attend Mass through no fault of their own (e.g. transportation issue).
- Those who are homebound and/or incapacitated due to age, infirmity and/or medical restrictions.
- Those who have compromised health conditions and/or at high risk of contracting the virus.
- Those who are caretakers of person who are sick or of persons at high-risk of serious illness if they contract Covid virus.


If you have any questions about any specific needs, concerns or protocols, you are advised to contact Fr. Eric. As your pastor, he has the authority to dispense in individual cases and may be helpful in addressing individual fears and concerns.

The obligation to attend Mass is a joyful one, reflecting the very character of who we are as Catholics.
