# Welcome

---

Dear friends in Christ,

Last weekend, I announced changes in my own priestly assignments as well as the naming of a new pastor for Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ Church. Effective July 1, 2026, Archbishop Charles Thompson has appointed me Vice Rector of Bishop Simon Brute College Seminary and Pastor of Holy Angels and St. Rita Churches in Indianapolis, while continuing as Archdiocesan Director of Seminarians. To care for the pastoral needs of this parish, Archbishop Thompson has appointed Fr. Ben Syberg as full-time pastor of Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ Church, also effective July 1. While change is never easy, I am confident that God will guide and direct all of us over the coming months of transition, and I am excited about the opportunity to engage more deeply in the formation of our future priests, a specialized ministry that is near to my heart and has been part of my own ministry for nearly 14 of my 22 years as a priest.

I am particularly grateful that Archbishop Thompson has given the care of this parish to a priest who will be here full-time, with no other assignments. And I believe Fr. Ben will be a great fit for this community and a good pastor for all of you. Fr. Ben grew up at Our Lady of the Greenwood Church in Greenwood and is a graduate of Roncalli High School - so he knows this part of Indianapolis well. He was ordained a priest in 2014 and is currently serving as an Advocate in the Metropolitan Tribunal and as Administrator of Holy Angels and St. Rita Churches in Indianapolis. He and I know each other well, and we have already begun to work together to ensure a smooth transition come July 1.

One final note - long before knowing that I would receive a new assignment and that the announcements would be made this past weekend, I had scheduled this week away for an annual vacation time with my mother. I'll be back in the parish this coming week, and I look forward to the coming two months of our time together before moving to the seminary at the beginning of July. Know of my prayers for you, and please pray for me, for Fr. Ben, and for all priests and parishes preparing for pastoral changes this summer.

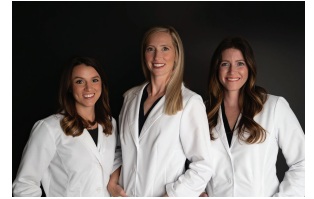
