"We Americans are sometimes rather myopic, thinking we are the center of the Church. It was a grace to realize that I am a small part of a larger reality. The Holy Spirit has descended on each of us, uniting us around the Lord's table.

"It is at such graced moments that I wonder why people around the world are in such violent conflict and even killing each other. Don't we realize that we are one - truly brothers and sisters? We are wounding our own body. It doesn't make sense."

Come Holy Spirit, and renew the face of the earth. Come to us, Spirit of God, breathe in us now. Fill us with the fire of your love, burn in us now, and bring us together. Come to us, dwell in us, and change our lives, Oh Lord, come to us, Spirit of God!


