

### Prayer



God desires to talk with us because he loves us. Prayer is our way of conversing with God. Because of the Holy Spirit, we can hear and be heard. As part of the Go Make Disciples evangelization initiative, Bishop Hying is challenging all members of the Diocese of Madison to pray daily for at least 15 minutes. If you already do this, then the challenge is to increase this time to 30 minutes and more. If you are new to this idea, start small and add minutes as you get comfortable praying for short periods of time. Begin with something manageable so that you are able to stick with your goal. Our world is in desperate need of people who pray. Commit to a praying daily and make a difference in our families, church, local communities, country, and world.

### Ways to Incorporate Prayer into Your Daily Life

- · Create a set time in your daily schedule that you spend in pray.
- Get up earlier and make prayer the first part of your day.
- Place a copy of the Morning Offering on your bathroom mirror, coffee pot, or someplace you see it every morning.
- . Pray the rosary daily. \*\*\*This is a recommended practice for all Catholics.\*\*\*
- Spend time in silence; that's when God speaks. Set a timer for just a few minutes to help you begin this
  practice. Arch Bishop Fulton Sheen said, "Prayer begins by talking to God, but ends by listening to Him."
- The greatest prayer is Holy Mass. Attend daily Mass. Eucharistic Adoration is also available.
- Pray in the car. Turn off the radio and devote your drive to prayer.
- Pray when you go for a walk.
- Pray while waiting in lines, between meetings, or while waiting for appointments.
- Pray the Liturgy of the Hours throughout the day. You can find these daily prayers online at divineoffice.org.
- Learn to read scripture and pray using Lectio Divina. There are some apps that might be helpful.
  - Lectio (Read) Listen carefully for words and phrases that seem to jump out.
  - Meditatio (Reflect) Read the passage again and reflect on what God is saying to you.
  - Oratio (Respond) Recording your thoughts in a journal can be helpful.
  - Contemplatio (Rest) Spend time in silent contemplation.
- Make a visit to church before or after work/school. This can be a quick sign of the cross in front of the tabernacle. God will be glad you stopped.
- Pray as a family before or after dinner. Do this when you eat out too!
- Teach your children new prayers or memorize a new one yourself.
- Find a Catholic book that you can read and mediate on. Example: There is a reflection book with prayers
  that can be used in accompaniment to St. Faustina's Diary.
- Listen and pray along with a CD of the Divine Mercy. "The Chaplet of Divine Mercy in Song" is nice.
- Set an alarm on your watch for 3:00 P.M., the Hour of Mercy, and pause to thank God for his willingness to die for our sins.
- · Pray novenas. Sign up at: p.praymorenovenas.com to receive novena prayers by email.
- Watch EWTN or sign up for Formed, Hallow, or another Catholic app and listen to prayers including the
  rosary. Find commentaries on the daily Gospel to help you pray with Scripture.
- Make it a habit to pray before making any decisions, big or small.
- When you hear a siren, pray for those in need and the first responders.
- When you go by a cemetery, pray for the dead.
- . Make a playlist of Catholic prayers and songs and listen to it while doing housework, yard work, or driving.
- Join the Sunday night (5:30 P.M.) or Monday evening (4:45 P.M.) prayer groups at Immaculate Conception.
- Have a conversation with the Lord. Tell him everything on your mind.
- Remember to thank God for good things he has done for you.


