





Reclaiming Sunday

As part of the Go Make Disciples Evangelization program, Bishop Hying is challenging all members of the Diocese of Madison to devote Sunday to faith and family. The Evangelization Team would like to challenge you to pick at least two or three ways you can make every Sunday a day that's more focused on the Lord. You may have many ideas of your own on how you can devote this one day a week to growing in your love of the Lord and helping your family to do the same. You may already do this, but could you do more? Here are a few ideas that the evangelization committee members brainstormed that might be of interest.

• AN ABSOLUTE MUST! ATTEND MASS!

- Come a little early or stay after Mass for extra prayer time.
- Visit the confessional monthly or more frequently than you currently do.
- Make Sunday a Day of Recollection in which you withdraw from the world and pay attention to the presence of God in your soul through silence, solitude, and contemplation.
- Set aside Sunday as a day for reading <u>only</u> Catholic material.
- Try to pray without distraction for a set length of time; 15 plus minutes would be a great goal, but start small. Even if it is just a few minutes, it's a start. Choose a length of time you can be successful at and increase it as you develop a habit of praying.
- Listen to only Catholic radio/songs on Sunday.
- Find a family friendly movie, maybe one that is Christian based, and watch it.
- Explore FORMED. This online resource is a subscription that has been paid for by the parish for your use. You can find movies, Bible studies, program series on the Holy Spirit, videos about saints, children's programs, etc. See the church bulletin for weekly suggestions. Log in for free at www.watched.formed.org using the Boscobel zip code (53805).
- Turn off the TV, YouTube, Facebook, gaming systems, Snapchat etc. and spend Sundays without technology.
- Plan a family dinner and include prayer. Enjoy a family game night.
- Say "no" to sports on Sunday
- Don't shop on Sundays.
- Learn about a Saint. Glory Stories from HolyHeroes.com are excellent audio CDs for children.
- Walk, hike, visit a park, or take a Sunday drive and enjoy God's creation.
- Call family members that live away.
- Visit those who live alone or are in the nursing home, if it is safe to do so.
- Pray the rosary as a family. If you live alone, call someone and pray together over the phone or computer.
