

The Most Precious Blood of Jesus Christ

This feast was celebrated as early as the 16th century in Spain. In 1849 Pope Pius IX extended the feast to the entire world and set it to be observed on the first Sunday of July.

Sadly, however, the feast was removed from the church calendar in 1969. The reason was that the Precious Blood is included in the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). The month of July is still dedicated to honoring the Most Precious Blood of Jesus.

Sacrifice is the highest form of religious worship that man offers to God as an act of praise, thanksgiving, petition, and atonement. The pre-eminent sacrifice of the Old Law was the immolation of the Passover Lamb, which celebrated the sparing of Israel's firstborn from the fatal sword of the Angel of Death in Egypt at the time of Moses.

During the Last Supper as Our Lord and His apostles celebrated the Passover, He offered Himself in an unbloody yet real sacrifice when He uttered the following words: ***For this is My blood of the covenant, which shall be shed for many unto the remission of sins.***-- Matthew 26: 28

The sacrifice of the Passover lamb took a new form the next day on Good Friday when the Immaculate Lamb of God offered Himself on the altar of the Cross to redeem mankind from sin and the slavery of Satan. We re-present both the Last Supper and the Crucifixion in every Mass during the Consecration. During Holy Communion we receive the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus into our own bodies.

Make an effort to visit Jesus in church or adoration chapel often. Offer the sacrifice of His Most Precious Blood to the Father in reparation for sins and the salvation of souls. Be aware of Who is present in Holy Communion; worship Him; talk to Him.




First Fridays & First Saturdays Devotions

First Friday Devotion at Immaculate Conception in Boscobel will be from 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm. This devotion honors the Sacred Heart of Jesus and is based on apparitions to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the late 17th century. Receive communion for 9 consecutive months and around the time of each reception, go to confession with the intention of fulfilling this devotion.

First Saturday Devotion at St. John the Baptist in Muscoda begins at 7:00 am with Holy Mass. This devotion consists of going to confession, receiving Communion, reciting 5 decades of the Rosary and meditating for a quarter of an hour on the mysteries of the Rosary on the first Saturday of five consecutive months.


