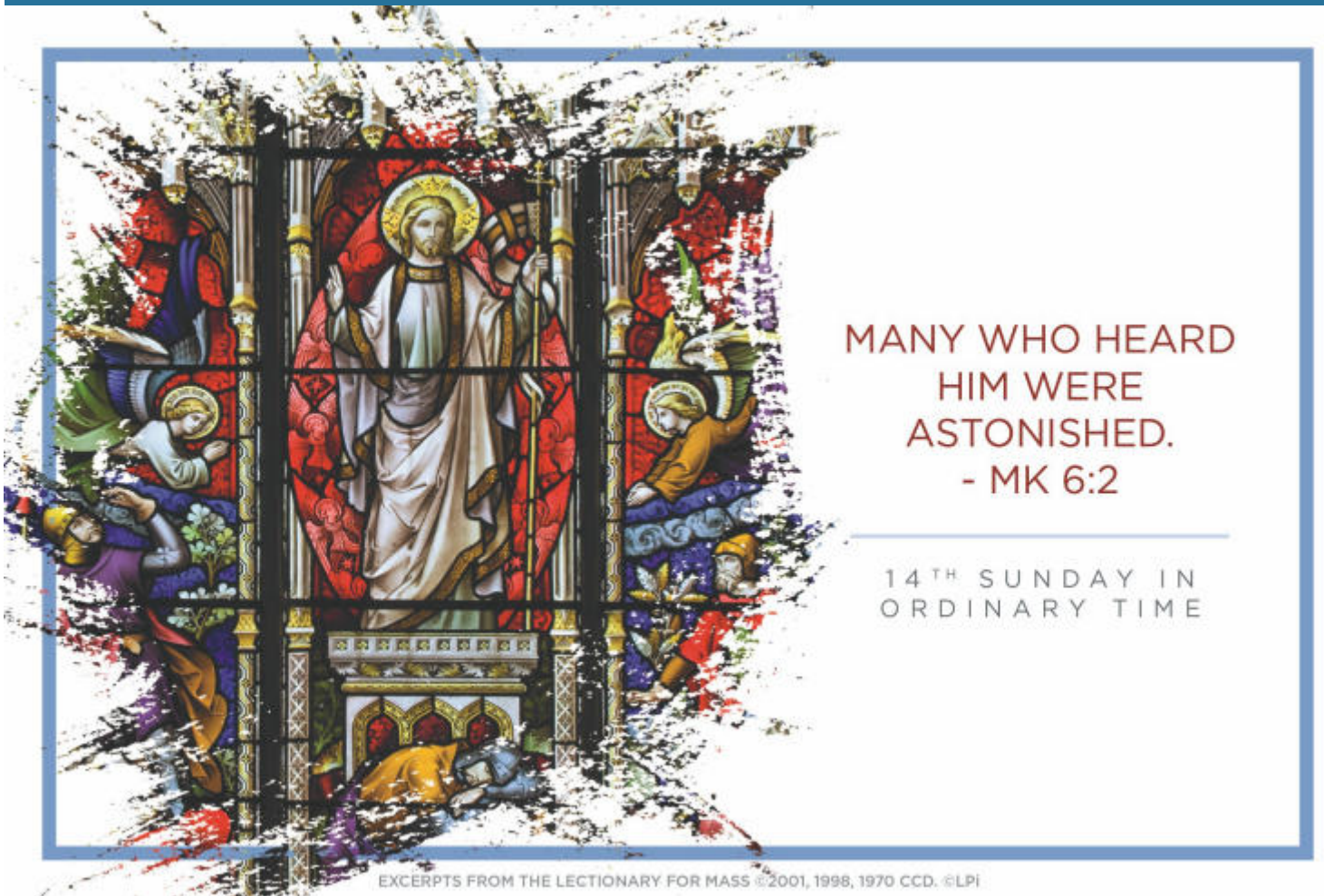

## New Hymnals and Missals

This weekend, we are adding books back in the pews. We are fortunate to have had the opportunity to get new books with the new church. You will notice there are now two books: a hymnal and a missal. The blue St. Michael Hymnal will contain most of the music. The red Lumen Christi Missal will have the readings, psalm, Gospel Acclamation, and sometimes communion. Because we have returned to using the books, we will be discontinuing the digital worship aid.



Numbers for the readings and music can be found once again on the number board behind the cantor. Numbers in the hymnal will be marked with a blue square while the missal numbers will have nothing. Starting at the top of the board, the numbers will notate the Readings, Entrance Hymn, Gloria, Offertory Hymn, Eucharistic Acclamations, and Communion Antiphon.

Finally, please take time to look toward the back of each book. There are many resources and prayers to use, even outside the Liturgy. It is a great resource if you are ever in need of a prayer. We are excited to use these excellent resources to aid in our worship of the Lord.

## TOTUS TUUS

Totus Tuus (Latin for *Totally Yours*) is a fun and energetic parish based summer catechetical program for both grade school age children and middle and high school youth. Totus Tuus gathers together college students and seminarians from across the United States onto teaching teams of four in order to train them and send them out on the road to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ in various participating parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. The teachers' youthfulness, energy, and ability to witness to the Faith make them particularly effective with children and young adults.



The **grade school program** is designed for children going into 1st through 6th grades in the upcoming school year. The program runs during the day from 9 am - 2:30 pm, Monday, July 19 - Friday, July 23. The evening program is for **junior high youth** (grades 7th-8th) and **high school youth** (grades 9th-12th). This group meet in the evenings from 7:30-9:45 pm, Sunday, July 18 - Thursday, July 22. The program is comprised of instruction, small group discussions, quiet meditation, prayer, and fellowship.

The fees to attend are as follows: one child - \$25; two children - \$40; three or more children - \$50. If paying these fees is a hardship for your family, please contact Jonathan Higgins at [jhiggins@stmichaelsgrfld.org](mailto:jhiggins@stmichaelsgrfld.org) or 317-462-4240. Volunteers are also needed for Totus Tuus! There will be two young men and two young women missionaries that will need a place to stay for the duration of the program. They will need to be housed in separate homes so two different hosts are needed. The missionaries will only need a place to sleep and a simple breakfast from their hosts.

Dinners are needed for the missionaries as well. You can have the missionaries in your home or bring dinner to the Parish Life Center and share the meal. If you can help with housing or meals, please contact Jonathan Higgins at the contact information above.

## World Grandparents Day

Pope Francis has announced the first annual World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly will be held on the 4th Sunday of July, which is July 25 this year. The Pope chose that date because it's close to the July 26 Feast of St. Anne and St. Joachim, the parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and the grandparents of Jesus Christ. The Pope said, "after a very difficult year, especially for elderly people, I wanted to offer them a day of encouragement, solidarity, and consolation".

Anyone who participates in the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly will earn a plenary indulgence. The Apostolic Penitentiary, an office at the Vatican which deals with indulgences, among other things, has declared that "grandparents, the elderly," and all Catholics who participate in the World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly can receive a plenary indulgence if they go to confession before, on, or after the day, receive the Eucharist, on or around the day, pray for the Pope's intentions, and if they can renounce their attachment to sin. The indulgence also extends to the homebound who spiritually unite their sufferings and crosses to the observance of World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly.

A plenary indulgence is "a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven." It is, in other words, freedom from the purgative purification that we need for unity with God because of the effect of our sins, even after they're forgiven.
