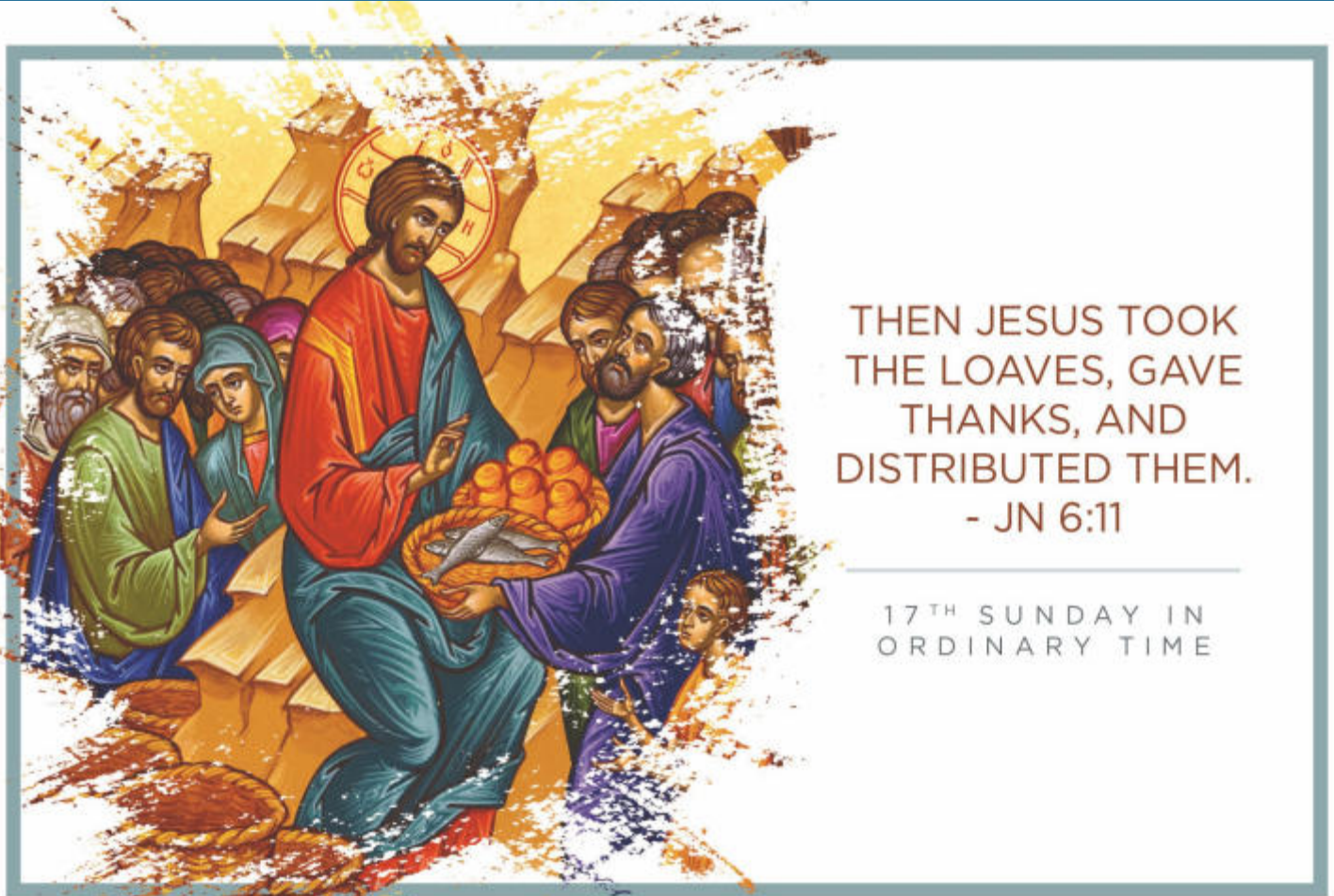

Basic donation requirements: You must be feeling healthy on the day of your donation. A Donor Services staff will confidentially review all current medications. You must be age 17 or older (16 with parent/guardian permission). Any healthy person 19 or older who weighs at least 110- 112 pounds may be eligible to donate. Donors age 16, 17, and 18 have special height and weight requirements. You are able to donate 48 hours after receiving a COVID vaccine. Before you donate: Know the medication names and dosage you take, bring a photo ID with your birth date listed, and plan for about one hour for your donation time.

New Prayer Garden

A huge thank you to Kayleigh Horne for choosing St. Michael to complete her Stars & Stripes project. Kayleigh was referred to St. Michael by Life Choices Pregnancy Care Center after expressing a desire to build a prayer garden for parents who have lost their children to abortion, miscarriage, and stillbirth. The garden is available to anyone who would like to come and pray for their child.

The garden consists of a rock path, flowers, concrete benches, and a plaque that reads, "Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted. Matthew 5:4". There are also small rocks placed around the prayer garden with words of encouragement and comfort. Life Choices will have rocks and paint available for any parent that would like to name their child and place a rock in the prayer garden in the child's memory.

In the fall, we plan to relocate the stone monument honoring the unborn that is currently located on the northwest side of the church to the new garden. Once the monument has been moved, Fr. Aaron will bless the new garden. More information on the blessing will be communicated when it is available.

How to Play Pink Envelopes
