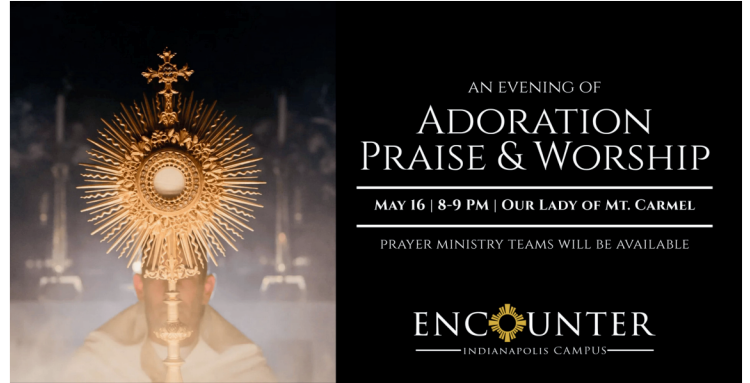

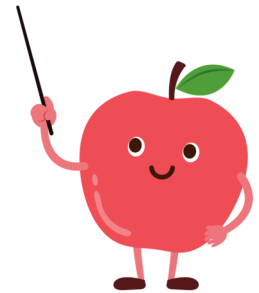
If you would like to have a Mass said for a loved one, please note that we have space for new intentions for May, June, and July. The customary donation is \$10 per Mass.

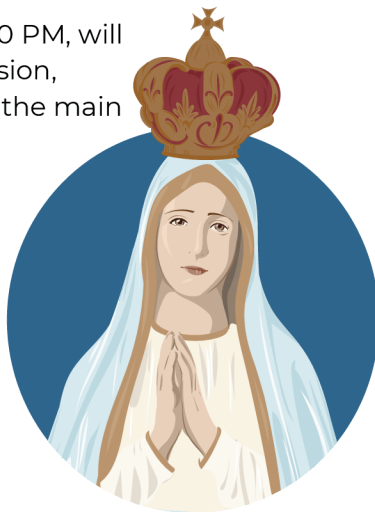
